## Youth 2013-14 Funding Scenarios

#### Notes:

Staff recommendations take the 5% cut first from a lower priority B2 program in which the City is 12% of the funding and has been funded for many years.

The other lower priority B3 program currently funded is a program that was first funded by the City two years ago and is planning to go from 71% City funding in 2012 to 40% of funds coming from City funding. A 10% cut was taken from this B3 priority to acknowledge that it was lower priority but to not disable the program to the point of non-existence. The remainder of the cut was taken from all other current programs and equals an ~2% decrease for each program.

There were several new programs proposed that address community needs and are of high quality. However, given the required funding limits staff could not justify moving funds from currently funded programs that have address needs and have been successful. The B-List recommendations below included the staff recommendations for reinstating the 5% cut, increasing current program funding and adding funds for new programs.
