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## **RESOLUTION 4032**

Background: The CDA introduced a revised Admission and Continued Occupancy Plan/ACOP (policies governing Public Housing) in January of 2013. It underwent public and community review for several months and was approved in May of 2013. One of the revisions made was in regards to the definition of Disposition in Chapter 3 Eligibility. The Disposition of a criminal matter included the payment of fines. The CDA found some denials were based on old fines. CDA staff and public comments received, favored revising the definition of disposition . Further that upon approving the ACOP, that it would be appropriate to revise the Administrative Plan (policies governing the Housing Choice (Section 8) Voucher program to have consistent policies regarding this matter.

**Whereas**, The CDA recently approved its Admission and Continued Occupancy Plan (ACOP) pertaining to the public housing policies;

**Whereas**, the CDA feels it is desirable to have policy consistency between the Public Housing and Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8) Programs whenever possible;
