

Notice of Public Hearing

Proposed Service Changes Affecting Routes 6, 10, 11, 12, 25, and 59

On Wednesday, May 13, Metro Transit and the City of Madison Transit and Parking Commission will hold a public hearing to discuss service changes proposed to go into effect this fall.

Route 25 Eliminated

- Route 25 is proposed for elimination due to service to American Family Insurance Headquarters now being provided on Route 26.
- Added trip to Route 6 (incorporated from Route 25 schedule).

Route 6 - Portage/Hayes Loop Change Heading to East Towne Mall

- Change in routing near East Towne. (Dwight Dr. and Independence Ln.)

Route 10

- West end of route expanded to serve UW Health-Digestive Clinic and other medical centers west of Whitney Way.
- Service along Division, Rutledge and Spaight streets eliminated.
- Trips added to schedule that only operate when UW classes are in session.
- Other schedule adjustments to balance passenger loads with other routes.

Routes 11 and 12

- Revised routing on west side to facilitate commutes between Toepfer Ave. neighborhood and the UW and VA hospitals.
- Routes no longer serve West Transfer Point. (service available on other routes)
- Route 11 removed from Science Dr. (service available on Route 6)
- Service added on Blackhawk Ave. north of Bluff St., Berwyn Dr., and Wedgewood Way. (AM only)

ROUTE 12 – Waunona Way Loop Service Eliminated

- Loop north of W. Broadway and west of Lake Point Dr. (operating on Fayette Ave., Waunona Way, and Frazier Ave.) is proposed for elimination.

Changes and updates to other routes could be discussed at this public hearing.
