I am the current president of the Greenbush Neighborhood Association and am writing to express my support for the latest version of the planned reconstruction of Regent Street. This plan has dedicated parking between Randall and Mills streets, widening to 4 lanes of traffic as Regent approaches Park. There are additional trees on the north side of Regent as well, which are a welcome addition.

Our association supports the plan outlined here and feels that it strikes the right balance between supporting the businesses that are along Regent, supporting a pedestrian-friendly environment, and reducing the sense that Regent in Greenbush is a 'pass-through' rather than a place to convene.

One item we would like to have a better understanding of is how pedestrian crossing will be handled in this plan, as it did not seem to be called out in the drawings we were presented.
