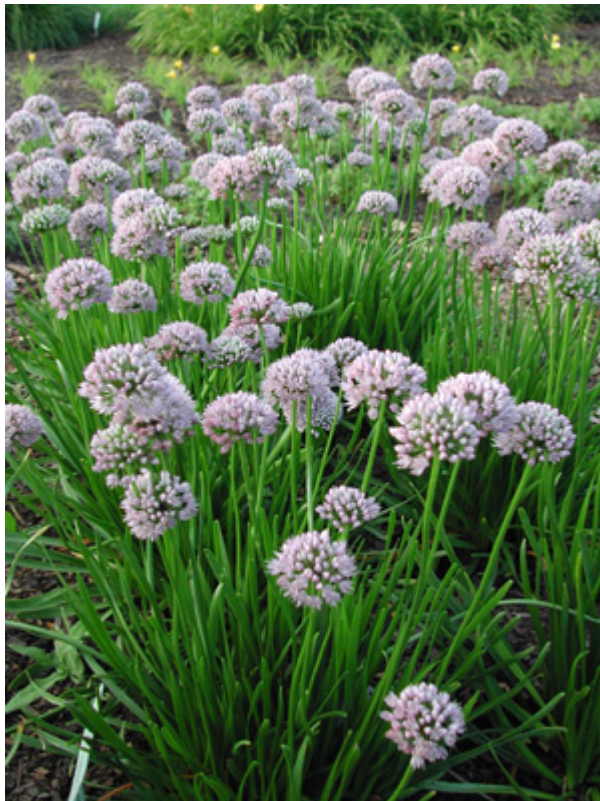

Spread: 12" to 18"

Form: clump-forming habit with tufted appearance, beautiful glossy leaves

Flower:
globes of pink-mauve flowers
blooming in May to June

Soil: prefers average, well-drained soils

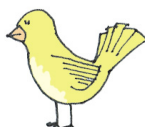
Sun/Shade: full sun to part shade

Uses: excellent when used in border garden, containers, herb/vegetable garden, or cutting garden

Maintenance:
low maintenance, deadhead after blooming if desired; cut back to the ground in late fall or early spring

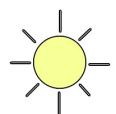

Sesleria autumnalis
Autumn Moor Grass



Height: 14" to 18" 24"-30" in flower

Spread: 18" to 20"

Form: clumping, upright form with a 'tuft like' habit

Foliage/Flower: bright yellow-green foliage with purplish black, wind responsive white stamened spikes persisting through the winter season

Soil: drought tolerant, although prefers a moist well-drained soil

Sun/Shade: full to part sun

Uses: a great ground cover, edging, massing or accent plant; also attractive to birds

Maintenance:
'neat tidy and well behaved'

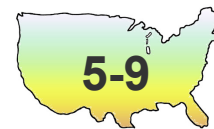

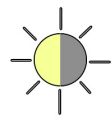

Beardtongue



Height: 24" to 36"

Spread: 12" to 24"

Form: upright clump-forming with medium green and purple leaves

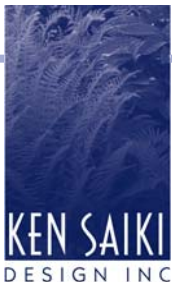
Flower: white (with hints of pink) two-lipped tubular flowers borne atop rigid stalks in April-June

Soil: prefers moist, average, dry to medium, wet, well-drained soil

Sun/Shade: full sun to part sun

Uses: perennial gardens, borders, as accent or massing

Maintenance: may divide every few years to prevent crowding

Moorflamme Purple Moor Grass



Height: 1'-2'

Spread: 2'

Form: a compact, symmetrical, vase shape

Foliage/Flower: rich, green leaves that color orange-red during the fall. A fine, purple bloom in summer.

Soil: normal, moist, well-drained soils.

Sun/Shade: full sun to partial shade

Uses: very versatile- use as edging, ground cover, as a border, in groups or as a single plant

Maintenance: low maintenance

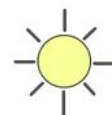

Miscanthus sinensis 'Gracillimus'
Maiden Grass



Height: 4 1/2'- 5 1/2'

Spread: 2'-3'

Form: compact form creating vase-like clumps

Foliage/Flower: beautiful narrow, longitudinally striped leaves. A maroon autumnal floral display and a golden fall color

Soil: Tolerates dry, sandy soil, also moderately tolerant to wet soils

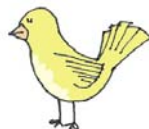
Sun/Shade: full sun to partial shade

Uses: Use as a border, as a screen or a specimen grass

Maintenance: low maintenance, some blights exist but are rare



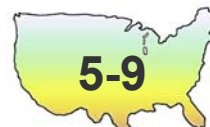

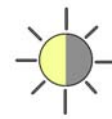

Spread: 6"-12"

Form: Grasslike, spreading clumps

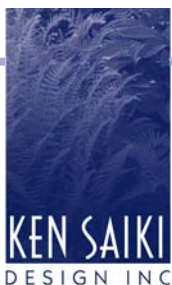
Foliage: Straplike 18" dark green leaves turning bronze-green in winter. Pale violet to white flowers in mid summer

Soil: Tolerates most soils as long as it is well-drained

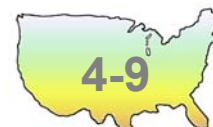
Sun/Shade: full to partial shade

Uses: Groundcover massings

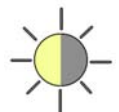

Height: 3' to 5'

Spread: 3' to 5'

Form: Round, compact form

Foliage, Flower, & Fruit:

Bright green new foliage with dark green mature foliage bejeweled with large crimson berries

Soil: Prefer wet, acidic soil. Will not do well in soils with high pH

Sun/Shade: Full sun to full shade

Uses: Used in foundations, massing, hedges, and backgrounds. Install a male pollinator for every 3 to 5 fruiting female plants

Maintenance:

Low maintenance, some cultivars need pollination



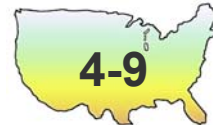

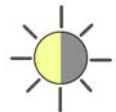

Hydrangea quercifolia 'Pee Wee'

Pee Wee Oakleaf Hydrangea



Height: 3' to 4'

Spread: 2' to 3'

Form: upright and compact, with a rounded habit

Foliage, Flower, & Fruit:

loose, elongated flower clusters; white fading to pink in summer; distinctive oak-like foliage turns maroon/bronze in fall

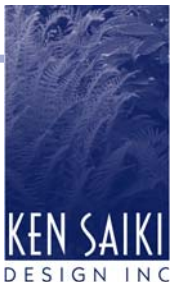
Soil: organically rich, well-drained, moist soils

Sun/Shade: full sun to partial shade

Uses: foundation, informal hedge, specimen, or mass planting; mass in open woodland areas

Maintenance:

little maintenance required, if desired prune out weak stems after flowering



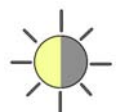

Height: 24"-36"

Spread: 2'-4'

Form: Dense, mounded, upright-spreading habit

Foliage, Flower, & Fruit:

oblong, dark green, leathery foliage with exquisite red, orange and yellow fall color. White blooms in late spring/early summer.

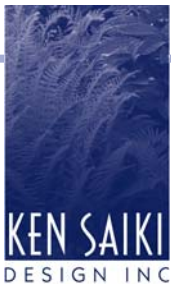
Soil: Moist, well-drained slightly acidic soils that are high in organic matter

Sun/Shade: Sun to partial shade

Uses: group or mass as border of foundation plantings. Easily paired with rhododendrons, which share almost identical soil requirements

Maintenance:

moderate, spreads by root suckers which must be removed promptly.



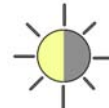

Deschampsia cespitosa 'Goldtau'
Goldtau Tufted Hair Grass



Height: 24" to 36"

Spread: 24" to 36"

Form: large, dense clumps of long, narrow, dark green leaves, highly ornamental-even throughout winter

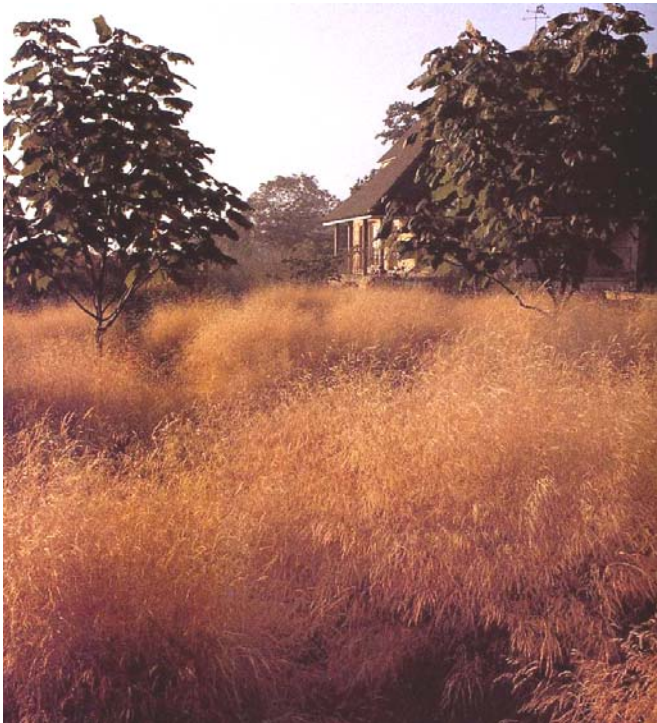
Flower: delicate, golden inflorescences 24" to 36" high, flowers in late June and July, but remain for quite some time afterward

Soil: will grow on all but dry soils, prefers waterlogged soils

Sun/Shade: full sun to part shade

Uses: natural gardens, mass plantings along walkways and driveways, or around bases of other plants

Maintenance: low when grown in full sun, may require pruning and staking in part shade

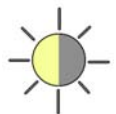

Calamagrostis x acutifolia 'Overdam'
Variegated Feather Reed Grass



Height: 18" to 24" 36" in bloom

Spread: 18" to 24"

Form: a narrow, tuft habit of lovely, narrow green and white striped foliage

Flower: rosey purple spike shaped inflorescences starting in june then turning light tan in late summer

Soil: moist to wet fertile soil, does well in a range of soil types, including dry sandy, and thrives in clay

Sun/Shade: full sun to part shade

Uses: wonderful in a border, a vertical accent, a hedge or screen or as a backdrop for roses and other perennials

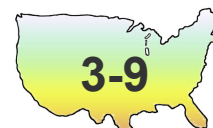
Maintenance: cut down in early spring, just before the new growth starts



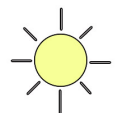
