

Sustainability Plan Review October, 2016

Four Sustainability Categories were analyzed.

- Natural Systems
- Planning and Design
- Transportation
- Carbon and Energy

Based on a review of the actions outlined in each of the sustainability category sections listed above, the City has completed or is in-process of completing 55% of the actions identified. Most of the in-process activities appear to be on-going regular work that support, implement or maintain the identified Plan actions.

Natural Systems highest area of non-completed actions is in the Restoring and maintaining natural systems area, actions that require regional planning and some that require regular review of pesticide use and replacement with organic options. Canopy and other tree issues also need follow-up.

Planning and Energy had the most completed and in-process items. Many of the in-process items relate to the on-going work of the Planning group.

Transportation's main on-going process is the Madison in Motion (Sustainable Madison Transportation Master Plan). Expanding transportation options, fostering better collaboration and maximizing alternative usage need the most attention.

Carbon and Energy, of the four categories selected by the SMC as priority areas, has the most incomplete actions. Many of the items that are listed as incomplete relate to the goals around influencing private sector action.
