This resolution authorizes the City to enter into a contract for design services for the planned Public Works Facility on the west side on South Point Rd., budgeted for construction to begin in 2026. To summarize, a request for proposals was issued through the City's purchasing processes, and 9 proposals were scored based on the technical aspects of the proposal (65 points), the cost component (30 points), and also included a local vendor score, consistent with City policies. The top 4 consultants then advanced to a 2nd round, which included an interview and a best and final offer cost proposal (BAFO). These 4 were then scored again based on the original technical proposal score from round 1 (65 points), the interview (65 points), the BAFO (60 points), and the local vendor preference once again (10 points). Following City purchasing guidelines and this noted review and scoring process, it is recommended that the City enter into a contract with the highest scoring firm, Sketchworks Architecture, LLC in the amount of \$1,590,783.

IMEG was selected in an RFP process to provide assessment reports for structural

engineering and mechanical electrical systems at Olbrich Botanical Gardens in 2023. Those reports noted the need for further enhanced assessments of the glazing system and for repair/replacement of some mechanical equipment at Bolz Conservatory. IMEG provided professional services through non-competitive selection in 2024 to complete the enhanced assessment work. The findings from the assessments indicated the need to repair and improve the existing conditions in the Bolz Conservatory. The contract will allow IMEG to prepare biddable construction documents and specifications and provide an accurate construction estimate tor budgeting purposes.
