lines. Bottles will be housed in the wells as well as displayed behind the bar. The backup liquor will be caged inside of the dry

storage/office that is located in the basement of the building. Alcohol will be allowed inside of the restourent

as well as the patio. The Patio is located on the side of the restour-nt and is raised above the parking structure. The Patio is enclosed with railing and a roof.
