Metropolitan Coffee and Wine L.L.C.

Executive Summary:

Metropolitan Coffee & Wine is a coffee and Wine shop located at 329 W. Mifflin St. It is a Limited Liability Company. This coffee and wine shop will serve coffee, sandwich, cheese, beer, and wine. It is located at the first floor of Metropolitan Place. This coffee and wine shop will provide casual social space for the building residents and surrounding neighbors. Metropolitan Coffee & Wine will be a comfortable and classic space for customers to enjoy. Nice dark solid wood furniture and elegant pendant lights will provide a nice work space for students, community groups, and sohos during daytime and warm setting in the evening.

Description of the Business:

Metropolitan Coffee & Wine will serve coffee drinks, beverage, bakery items, sandwich, cheeses, beer, and wine. Metropolitan Coffee and Wine will start on October 30th, 2012. Metropolitan Coffee & Wine is trying to provide a comfortable and classic space for the downtown area. The unique feature of Metropolitan Coffee & Wine is related to the large Metropolitan Place building. Metropolitan Place Phase I building and Phase II building has about 300 residents. This coffee and wine location is designed to serve building residents and guests as the top priority. Metropolitan Coffee and Wine will use the best roasted coffee beans from Wisconsin local Berry's Brother at Watertown. It will also use milk and large portion of the cheese from local farmers.

Market Analysis and Strategy:

The main target customers are residents in Bassett neighborhood especially residents at Metropolitan Phase I and Phase II building and community social groups. There are many sohos in Bassett neighborhood. Main components of the customers are students and professionals. Majority of the residents at Metropolitan Phase I and Phase II building are professionals. Metropolitan coffee and wine is also located between Madison Opera and Overture Center and renovated library. There will be decent foot traffic on W. Mifflin Street. Cross the street is the Madison senior center and capital market. Metropolitan Coffee and Wine will try to provide comfortable and welcoming spaces for all the guests and let them feel comfortable to come back with their friends and families. It will also provide meeting spaces for community culture groups and social groups. There is also a large parking facility cross the street.

Metropolitan Coffee and Wine will price the products at average pricing point comparing to foot establishment around capital area. Overtime, Metropolitan Coffee and Wine will continue to improve décor and variety of choices in order to keep customers. Metropolitan do not plan to expand market too fast or too wide. It has its target customers and will focus on the target customers. Metropolitan coffee and wine will be focusing on providing the best coffee and pairing the food with wine.

Around capital area, there are many coffee shop, bar, and food establishment. Metropolitan coffee and wine is trying to provide a comfortable space for residents in Bassett neighborhood. The chars are comfortable and large for longer seating time. Tables are solid wood with different size for community social group meetings. The purpose of this coffee and wine shop is to provide a comfortable and classic space for the communities.

Location and Operations:

Metropolitan coffee and wine is located at 329 W. Mifflin St. Surrounding businesses are Capital Market, Madison Opera, Overture Center, Madison Library, Madison Senior Center. There is one 4 stories public parking garage cross the street for easy access. There are also metered parking spots and free 2-hour parking spots along W. Mifflin St. Metropolitan coffee and wine is about 2800 sqft. There are a lot of potentials for the use of the space.
