RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Community Development Authority (CDA) of the City of Madison Low-income Public Housing properties have many trees that need trimming or removal, (especially Ash trees); and

WHEREAS, the CDA would benefit from expert analysis of its tree removal and replacement priorities; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Tree Alliance has received a grant from the Wisconsin Dept. of Natural Resources of \$25,000 to conduct a tree inventory and a tree management plan for the CDA and;

WHEREAS, the American Transmission Company, (ATC) also awarded \$3,751.00 in grant funds to purchase and plant 40 trees at CDA Public Housing sites; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin DNR requires a cooperative agreement between the project sponsor, Urban Tree Alliance and the project partner, CDA and;

WHEREAS, the City Attorney's Office and the City's Risk Manager have reviewed and approved the draft agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Community Development Authority is authorized to enter into a cooperative grant agreement with the Urban Tree Alliance under the Wisconsin DNR Urban Forestry Grant program.
