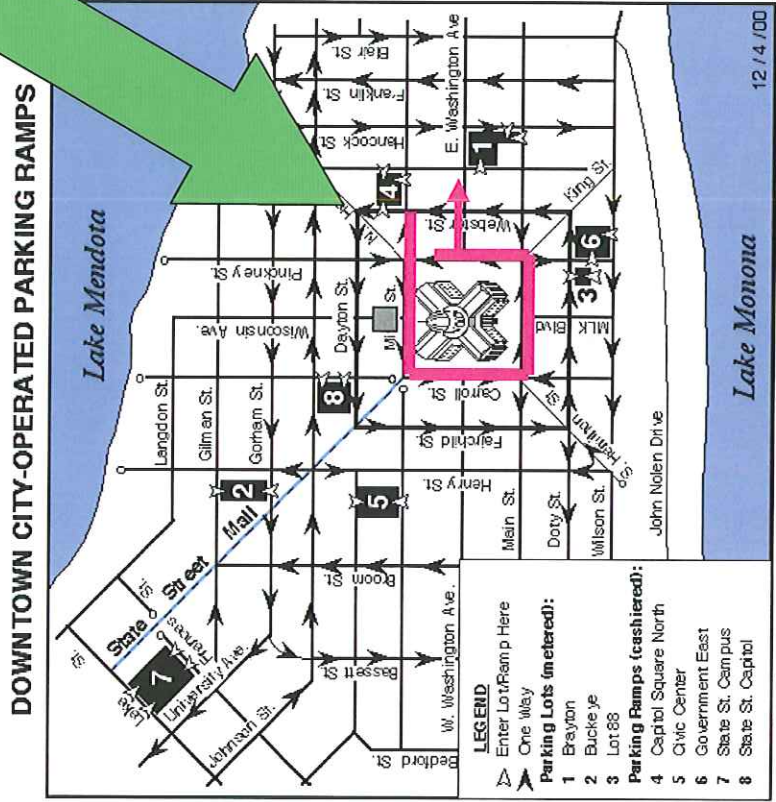
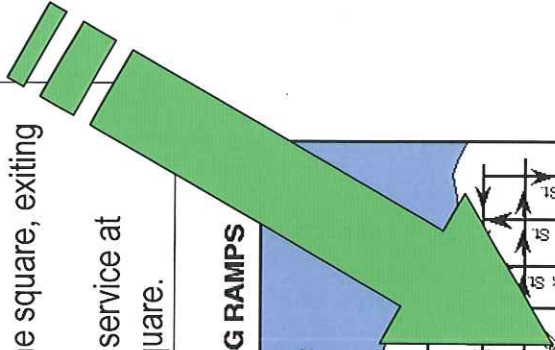

MARCH 13, 2011 1:30pm

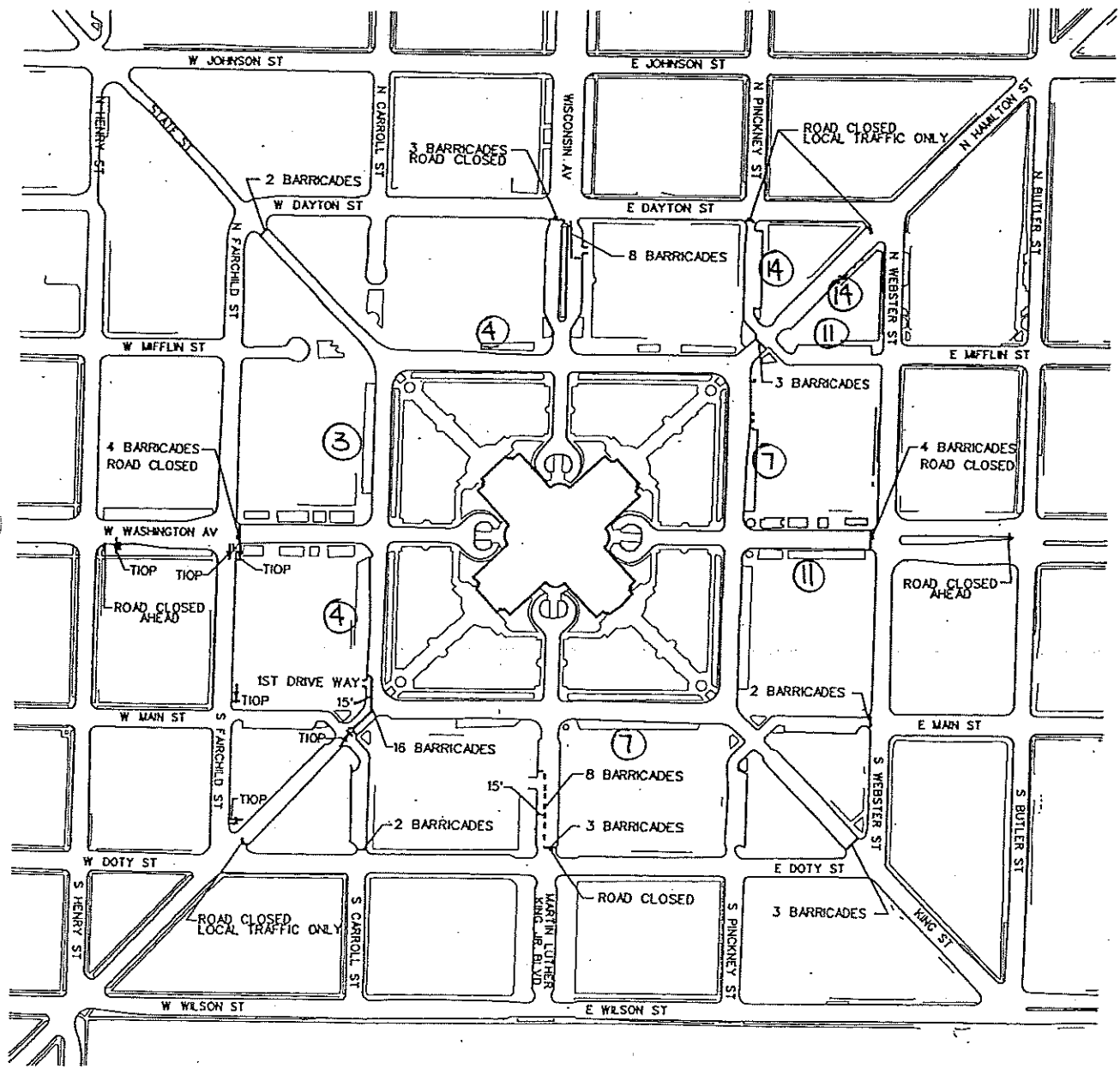
- Parade steps off from the intersection of N. Pinckney and E. Mifflin St. (Headquarters location).

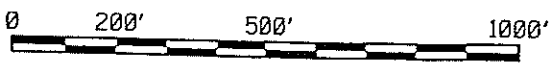
