The Wisconsin Department of Transportation proposes to reconstruct University Avenue from Allen Boulevard to Segoe Road, in the cities of Madison and Middleton. A map of the project area, showing record numbers from the Wisconsin Historical Society's Architecture/History Inventory, is enclosed.

I am helping identify any buildings and structures that may be eligible for the National Register of Historic Places in the area adjacent to this project. Following field review and historical research, it is my opinion that the following resources are potentially eligible for the National Register: The Merrill Springs Inn Motel complex at 5101 University Avenue; the Marshall Erdman & Associates building at 5117 University Avenue; the Spring Harbor School at 1110 Spring Harbor Drive; the potential Blackhawk Park Historic District along Craig Avenue; and the Harold and Lorraine White House at 1705 Hickory Drive. I am writing to ask whether the Madison Landmarks Commission is aware of any other historic resources in the area of this project, especially any that you feel might be affected by this project. 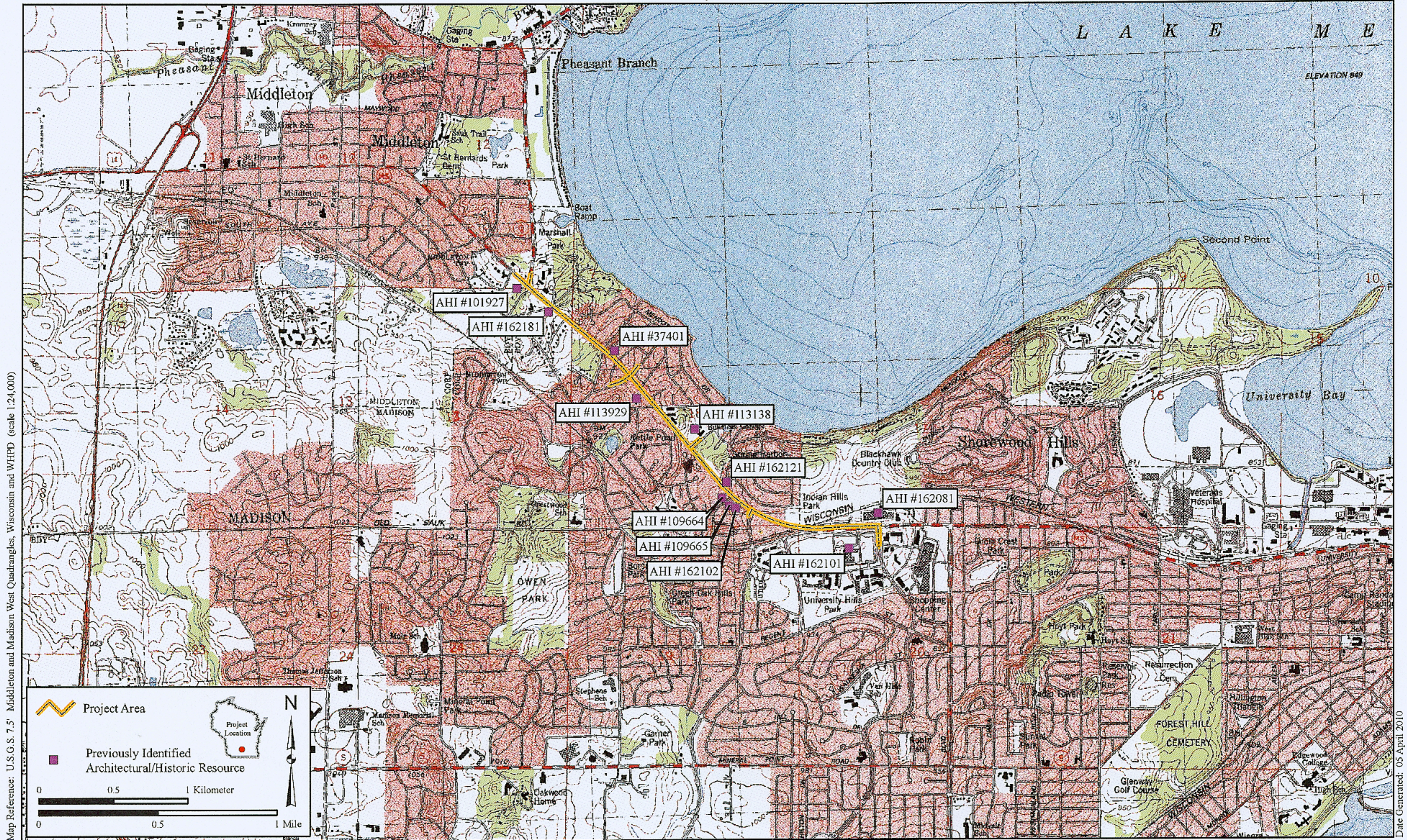
