## **Detailed Justification Summary**

Item #1 – Contract anticipated several inches of salvageable aggregate path surface to be salvaged and replaced. The corridor section east of Seminole Hwy, for approximately 3,600 LF, was discovered to have no reusable aggregate surface material. The price of \$13.80/ton to supply and place 1.5" crushed stone was negotiated and determined acceptable in November 2009. The stone was installed in May 2010.

Item #2 – An unmarked, abandoned lift station was encountered on the pipeline alignment in an easement through CDA property. An additional 2-hours of concrete removal work was required.

Item #3 – Six conflicts were encountered differing from shown survey utility location or slope grade elevation. The field resolution required a greater depth of the water main in these isolated areas. The greater depth necessitated installing hydrant extenders to bring the hydrants to the required bury line clearance.

Item #4 – Horizontal directional drilling operations resulted in excess fluid that was in too liquid of a state to spread on site, and site limitations limited on-site storage pits. The mud was intended to be hauled to a clean-fill site, however lab testing displayed levels of arsenic beyond the industrial contaminant level. The result was additional hauling time and distance requirements to access the county landfill, rather than the clean-fill site.

## Walt,

Thanks for stopping by today to discuss the unresolved change order for the Cannonball Pipeline project. As we discussed, here is the summarized breakdown of extra hauling expense that was caused by moving the destination for the drilling mud spoils from Clayton's pit to the County landfill. In summary, the change in location had added 32 minutes to each of the 57 loads hauled from the project site. This caused a need for using an additional vactor to haul mud for 2 days, additional trucking during pullback, and to have two additional days of trucking during additional clean-up after the drill operations were complete.

The total agreed additional expense, as described below, was \$7,166.

Please review the summarization below, and submit the revised change order if you concur that the following information is accurate.

#### Basis:

- There were 57 trips to the County landfill associated with the drilling mud/extra cleanup.
- Both parties agree that there was an extra 12 minutes per round-trip travel time and also an extra 20 minutes per trip to weigh-in/out at the landfill scales. That equates to 32 extra minutes per trip due to the location change (0.533 hrs).
- 40 of the 57 landfill trips were during pullback occurring between 11/11 and 11/18, with 9 of those coming from either of the two vactors and 31 from trucking.
- 17 of the 57 trips were during extra cleanup work occurring 11/30 to 12/1, with no vactor usage.

Contract: 6382 - CHANGE ORDER 2 - SUMMARY OF ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

- Additional Vactor rate = \$189/hr.
- Additional Trucking rate = \$76/hr.

Agreed Excess Handling Expense:

#### Pullback - extra vactor

9 trips \* 0.533 hr \* \$189 = \$907 - the actual extra expense

\*BUT\* assume 2 full days rental req'd for extra vactor per field notes.

Pullback - extra trucking

31 trips \* 0.533 hr \* \$76 = \$1,257 – the extra trucking expense during pullback

TOTAL PULLBACK EXTRA EXPENSE = \$ 3,591 + \$1,257 = \$4,848

## Additional clean-up - extra trucking

17 trips \* 0.533 hr \* \$76 = \$689 – the actual extra expense for trucking time

\*BUT\* assume, as invoiced 11/30 to 12/1, extra 30.5 total trucking excess time during 11/30 - 12/1

30.5 hrs \* 76 = \$2,318

TOTAL EXTRA HAULING/CLEAN-UP EXPENSE = \$2,318

## TOTAL EXTRA RESULTING FROM COUNTY

LANDFILL HAULING REQUIREMENT = \$2,318 + \$4,848 = \$7,166
