TO: Property owners along Hawthorne Court

RE: Proposed Street Reconstruction Project & Public Hearing

The City of Madison is proposing to reconstruct Hawthorne Court in 2026. The proposed improvements will include replacement of existing pavement surface and base, curb, gutter, sanitary sewer main and laterals, storm sewer main and inlet drains and potentially water main. It will also include installation of new concrete sidewalk. Enclosed with this letter is a fact sheet with details on the proposed project along with a notification for the Public Hearing before the Board of Public Works. The date and time of the public hearing can be found on the notification.

This project will involve special assessments to the owners of property adjacent to the project. The property owners will be assessed for various items included with this proposed project, and the costs of those items are assessed fully or partially to the owner. A table detailing the City's standard assessment policy for these items is included in the attached fact sheet.

Also included with this letter is a preliminary Schedule of Assessments, which shows the estimated costs for your property adjacent to the project. The Schedule of Assessments for all properties adjacent to the project is available on the project webpage at: www.cityofmadison.com/HawthorneCourtReconstruction; a hard copy can be mailed to you upon request. The frontages of each property to be assessed are listed on the full schedule. After work is complete, a final assessment cost will be calculated based on bid prices and work actually performed. The final assessment cost, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with the 4% interest charged on the unpaid balance.



Sanitary Sewer: Replace the existing sanitary sewer mains with new PVC pipes and replace laterals from the main to the property line.

Storm Sewer: Replace the existing storm sewer main with new concrete pipes, inlets and access structures as needed to convey street runoff.

Street: Hawthorne Court will be fully reconstructed with this project, including new roadway gravel, concrete curb & gutter, concrete pavement, and concrete sidewalk.

Hawthorne Court will be reconfigured as a northbound one-way street, to improve traffic flow. All traffic will enter from the south at University Avenue and proceed north, then take a left into the bus terminal and exit onto Lake Street. In order to exit, residents of properties 627 State St, 629 State St, 631 State St, 639 State St, 645 State St, 651 State St, 440 Hawthorne Ct, 444 Hawthorne Ct, and 449 Hawthorne Ct will drive south until reaching the bus terminal entrance and then turn right to exit onto Lake Street through the bus terminal. There is no southbound traffic allowed past the bus terminal entrance.

Maintenance Responsibilities: On the westerly side of the street, it is the fronting property owner's responsibility to maintain the concrete sidewalk for snow removal purposes.

Assessments: The final assessments will be mailed in 2027. Property owners can pay the assessments in a lump sum or over 8 years with a 4% interest rate.

Project Website: Updates will be regularly posted to the project page throughout construction, along with the project plan. The full schedule of assessments can also be viewed here as well as supplementary information about related projects such as State Street Campus Garage.

Construction Schedule & Impacts

Tentative Schedule: This project is scheduled to be bid in spring 2026. Construction is expected to begin spring/summer 2026 and be finished fall 2026. Construction is expected to take around 4 months to complete.

Traffic Impacts: Construction will be split into 2 phases: construction between the existing City parking garages and construction on the north/south ends of Hawthorne Court.

Reconstructing Street between Existing Parking Garages:

Northern properties (627 State St, 629 State St, 631 State St, 639 State St, 645 State St, 651 State St, 440 Hawthorne Ct, 444 Hawthorne Ct, and 449 Hawthorne Ct) will travel on Lake St, turn right onto State St, and turn right into Hawthorne. To exit, these residents will take State St west to exit onto Lake St. Southern Properties (616 University Ave, 620 University Ave, 622 University Ave, 624 University Ave, and 411 Hawthorne Ct) will enter from University Ave and turn into Hawthorne Ct. To exit, these residents will exit back onto University Ave.

Reconstructing Street on North and South Ends:

Hawthorne Court will be closed to thru traffic during construction work. Access to parking lots will be restricted during concrete installation and curing time. Parking Utility will address parking needs during such time.

During these disruptions, the Contractor will work with residents to provide access as quickly as possible. Please contact the project manager if you have accessibility concerns and need to request special accommodations.

Refuse Collection: It will be the contractor's responsibility to allow for refuse collection to continue during construction. Please mark your address on your cart to make sure it is returned if moved. We ask that you place your carts at University Avenue the evening prior to or at the very latest 6:00 a.m. the morning of your scheduled refuse/recycling day.

Supplemental Forestry Information

Tree pruning in advance of the project is required to reduce the risk of damage to the trees during construction.

The City of Madison Forestry Section will perform the necessary work. For certain species, especially oak and elm trees, the pruning must be completed by April 1 to reduce the chance of disease. If additional trees need to be removed, City Engineering will notify the adjacent property owner prior to removal. Street trees provide many benefits to our city and are considered an important part of the city's infrastructure. Forestry Section staff will evaluate the terrace for new planting sites and potential replacement sites when the project is complete. There is no additional cost to the adjacent property owner for a tree planting. Street trees are typically planted in the spring of the year following the completion of the construction project. Per Madison General Ordinance 10.10, City Forestry determines tree species and planting locations. Residents cannot choose or plant their own tree in the terrace.
