The Parking Utility is considering removing the special event sign that is under the Disabled Parking sign, though if this were done event organizers would be required to pay to have the Disabled Parking sign covered. Commission members inquired as to the cost to cover signs. Putnam said that it was his understanding that the cost is \$75 per sign, payable to the City Traffic

Engineering Division.

Putnam will review the status of removing the special event signing and cost to cover the Disabled Parking sign and report at next meeting.
