Board of Health for Madison and Dane County 2008 State Contracts

Resolution #2007-#18

The Department has received two 2008 contracts from the Division of Public Health, Department of Health and Family services:

- The Consolidated Contract (\$425,166) for chronic disease prevention, maternal-child health, immunizations, childhood lead, and radon prevention. This is a merger of the contracts that were held by the two agencies last year.
- Public Health Preparedness (\$270,264) is a combination of the County and City contracts for emergency preparedness.

In previous years, the Dane County Division of Public Health and the Madison Department of Public Health would have each received a contract similar to these. For 2008, these contracts are in the name of the merged agency. The Board of Health is authorized to accept continuation grants that had been previously approved by the County and City (IGA, VIII, F, 1).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County, on behalf of Public Health—Madison and Dane County is authorized to enter into two contracts with the Division of Public Health, Wisconsin State Department of Health and Family Services, including the Consolidated Contract for chronic disease prevention, maternal-child health, immunizations, childhood lead, and radon prevention for \$425,166 and the Emergency Preparedness contract for \$270,264 for the period January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008, and the Director is authorized to sign the contract agreements.
