Thank you again for coming to the Landmarks Commission meeting of February 17, 2014. In addition to the condition that the Landmarks Commission placed on the Certificate of Appropriateness, I have been advised by the State to remind you that any reconstruction of the damaged mound must be coordinated with the State pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 157.70. The Certificate of Appropriateness letter stated conditions related to the criteria for compliance with the Landmarks Ordinance and the lack of reference to the State Burial Law was not intended to mislead you into thinking that you were not obligated to coordinate your work with the State.
