<u>Informational Presentation Item:</u> <u>Review of Traffic Calming Projects & Disadvantaged Neighborhoods</u>

Attached please find a map showing traffic calming projects and economically challenged neighborhoods. Since the inception of the NTMP (Neighborhood Traffic Management Program) in the late 1990s, we have implemented 85 plus projects and encompassed most areas of the City—those areas where traffic calming can be installed. Consider for example that in older areas of the City, the City will not install traffic calming until the street is brought up to urban standards—with curb and gutter. This is to keep traffic from trying to use the shoulder to avoid a traffic calming device.

TE Staff work closely with the Mayor's Office on the Neighborhood Resource Teams, and is one of several city agencies that implement projects as a result of this program.
