






- Amendment to landmark designation for 619 W Mifflin to reflect boundary change




Wiedenbeck-Dobelin Warehouse

Common Council Approvals

Applicable Standards

MGO 41.18(4) Land Divisions and Combinations. The commission shall approve a certificate of appropriateness for land divisions, combinations, and subdivision plats of landmark sites and properties in historic districts, unless it finds that the proposed lot sizes adversely impact the historic character or significance of a landmark, are incompatible with adjacent lot sizes, or fail to maintain the general lot size pattern of the historic district.

MGO 41.07 (9) Amending a Landmark Designation. Any person may petition the Landmarks Commission to amend a Landmark Designation. The process for amending a landmark shall be the same as for designating a landmark under subsections (1)—(7) above.



Applicable Standards

MGO 28.144 Any development on a zoning lot adjoining a landmark or landmark site for which Plan Commission or Urban Design Commission review is required shall be reviewed by the Landmark Commission to determine whether the proposed development is so large or visually intrusive as to adversely affect the historic character and integrity of the adjoining landmark or landmark site. Landmark Commission review shall be advisory to the Plan Commission and the Urban Design Commission.

MGO 41.18(1) New Construction or Exterior Alteration. Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation

MGO 41.18(2) Demolition or Removal.



Staff Recommendation
