Edgewood does not have a place to call home. At the current time, each sport has a different home field and I feel it is confusing and plain unfair.

EHS is also proposing and spending additional money in order to keep the sound levels to a minimum. I don't feel that a couple of people, making a lot of noise, should be able to ruin it for all of those deserving students. These students and student athletes belong to a school community and are missing out on what should belong to every school...a home field. It has been proven that when kids/students are involved in sports, there is a less likelihood that they will become involved in bad behavior. In a day and age, where there are so many other problems with our youth, why would we not want to help these kids?

I feel strongly, that when you buy a home near a school, there are certain things that go along with it. I really believe that if there are issues that arise, the staff at EHS will address it immediately.
