SUMMARY:

Matthew Roggensack, registering in support and wishing to speak. Roggensack explained that the balconies are not visible from the street. He explained that the balcony spaces provide another exit for emergencies, provide some extra storage space and will provide an element of safety. Staff explained that the proposed alteration distorts the historic appearance and that the enclosure should incorporate elements of the original porch. Roggensack provided a revised elevation showing the elements requested by staff.
