Re: Affordable Housing Trust Fund Applications

Dear Mr. Hurie and Madison Alders:

I am an attorney who lives and practices in Madison. I recently read an article in the Isthmus about Occupy Madison, Inc. buying a building on Fordem Avenue and hoping to secure city funds from the Affordable Housing Trust Fund to offer permanent housing. I am writing to express my support for Occupy Madison, Inc.'s funding application and to oppose granting funds to Care Net Pregnancy Center of Dane County. Please give this letter to all relevant decision makers for this issue.

The article stated that Occupy Madison, Inc. is seeking \$275,000 in city funding through the Affordable Housing Trust Fund. Apparently, the group's short-term plan is to operate as a mission house and the long-term goal is to offer single-residency occupancy units to some 20 to 25 homeless individuals. The article further stated that Occupy Madison Inc.'s application for Affordable Housing Trust Fund money is one of four applications currently under review by the city. The article implied that Occupy Madison, Inc. would be competing with Care Net Pregnancy Center of Dane County, the evangelical anti-abortion group, for funds.

As a citizen concerned about homelessness issues, and with a professional background in separation of state/church and reproductive justice, I am writing to state that I believe that funding Occupy Madison, Inc.'s project would have a more positive impact on this community than funding Care Net Pregnancy Center of Dane County's project. I am an admirer of the Occupy movement and I have been personally impressed with Occupy Madison's emphasis on hearing the voices of all of its members and of their practice to provide a community for disenfranchised citizens of Madison. Homeless citizens in

Madison are not only disenfranchised, but criminalized—if they have used up their limited time in shelters or if they do not meet shelter admission criteria, they have no legal place to exist, let alone a forum in which to be heard and taken seriously. Occupy Madison has helped fill this void.

Additionally, as an attorney who has worked on separation of state/church issues, I am concerned about using city funds to help finance Care Net Pregnancy Center of Dane County. Care Net is an overtly evangelical organization. Their national website states that “The ultimate aim of Care Net and its network of pregnancy centers is to share the love and truth of Jesus Christ in both word and deed.” It is my opinion that granting Care Net’s funding application would violate the rights of conscience of the many Madison residents who oppose government resources being used to support fundamentalist ministries with anti-abortion agendas.

Furthermore, the *Wisconsin Journal of Law, Gender & Society* recently published my legal comment advocating for regulation of Crisis Pregnancy Centers, such as those run by Care Net, which commonly mislead and manipulate women who are facing unintended pregnancies to further their evangelical mission. My comment, “Crisis Pregnancy Centers Should be Regulated by Consumer Protection Statute in Wisconsin,” reviewed information from recent studies of Crisis Pregnancy Centers conducted by Senator Waxman and the Committee on Government Reform, the National Abortion Federation (NAF), and the National Abortion and Reproductive Rights Action League (NARAL), which demonstrate that Crisis Pregnancy Centers commonly give out misleading information, attempt to delay abortions, and use emotionally manipulative strategies in an effort to dissuade women from getting abortions. While none of these studies investigated Care Net of Dane County specifically, I am concerned about the missions and agendas of Crisis Pregnancy Centers in general and believe that giving financial aid to a Crisis Pregnancy Center may have a negative community impact.

For example, a study prepared for Senator Waxman (D-CA), found that Crisis Pregnancy Centers created an intentional barrier to abortion when they misled and manipulated women who were facing unplanned pregnancies. The Waxman Report revealed that 87% of the Crisis Pregnancy Centers contacted provided false or misleading information about the health effects of abortion. For example, Crisis Pregnancy Centers gave misleading information about a link between abortion and breast cancer, despite the well-accepted medical consensus that induced abortion does not cause an increased risk of breast cancer. Many Crisis Pregnancy Centers also falsely and misleadingly told women that abortion has negative impacts on future fertility and mental health. Thus, the Waxman Report determined that Crisis Pregnancy Centers’ frequent failure to provide medically

accurate information and their gross misstatements about the risks of abortion prevented women from making an informed decision about how to manage an unwanted pregnancy.

There is no lack of Crisis Pregnancy Centers in this state. As of 2007, there were 116 Crisis Pregnancy Centers in Wisconsin and that number has almost certainly grown. There is, however, a lack of services for low income and homeless citizens that are not run with an underlying agenda. Instead of helping to fund an organization that imposes its evangelical and anti-abortion agenda on those who receive services, I urge you to prioritize Occupy Madison, Inc.'s project, because the organization has a history of listening to and serving the needs of homeless and disenfranchised members of Madison.

CDBG Committee Members,

I'm writing to ask you not to approve CareNet's request for funding, which they say they will use to provide services to residents of a proposed local affordable housing unit. Based on this group's previous record of giving medically inaccurate and damaging information to women, such as that abortion causes breast cancer, and their history of using deception, guilt and shame to pressure females to avoid choosing abortion, it is wrong to consider funding them with tax dollars. This group has a history of obscuring its anti-choice agenda to the people it serves.

Further, there is no guarantee that this group won't use these dollars towards funding political anti-choice efforts, an especially egregious use of tax dollars.

I support the use of tax dollars for much needed local affordable housing, but please make sure that groups you decide to fund give honest, medically accurate, unbiased information to the clients they serve with tax dollars.

Re: Reject Care Net Funding

Dear Chair Markofski and Committee Members:

I am writing on behalf of the Freedom From Religion Foundation (FFRF) to object to financing a Care Net Pregnancy Center of Dane County housing project through use of \$150,000 in HOME Funds and \$400,000 Affordable Housing Trust Funds. FFRF is a national nonprofit organization with 1,400 members in Wisconsin including over 450 members in the Madison area.

We are very concerned that these funding grants will ultimately be used to subsidize an evangelical Christian and anti-abortion ministry and will not further the purposes of the designated funds. This proposal would subsidize a harmful and exclusionary religious ministry and violate City of Madison non-discrimination provisions and the constitutional principle of separation of state and church.

Pervasively Evangelical Care Net Program

FFRF reviewed the application and supporting materials submitted to the Committee. It seems that Care Net has provided little information about its purposes and programming, which are relevant to how this project will be implemented. A review of Care Net's purpose and programming is also appropriate given required nondiscrimination provisions in any contracts with the City of Madison for arrangements of this type.

The Care Net organization describes itself this way: "The ultimate aim of Care Net and its network of pregnancy centers is to share the love and truth of Jesus Christ in both word and deed." Care Net Pregnancy Center of Dane County's mission statement is:

We are a caring network of resources dedicated to equip, empower and support women and men to CHOOSE LIFE for their unborn children and to make wise life choices for themselves and their families.

With loving compassion, we minister to those affected by abortion and share with all the hope, forgiveness and peace found in a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.¹

In its statement to volunteers, Care Net describes its programming this way:

Care Net Pregnancy Center is a 4-pronged ministry providing support to women and their families who are experiencing unplanned pregnancies; Bible study support for those experiencing post-abortion stress (Whole Heart); abstinence education to teens in schools, churches and clients who visit the center; plus a Maternity home program (The Elizabeth House) for pregnant mothers over 18. In all situations, we are looking to share, in word and deed, the love of Christ.²

The volunteer questionnaire says, "This organization is a Christian pro-life ministry."³ The Statement of Faith that volunteers must sign outlines seven Christian articles of faith that volunteers must affirm, including:

The church is the body of Christ, comprised of all those who through faith in Christ have been regenerated by the indwelling Holy Spirit. The mission of the church is worldwide evangelization and the nurture and disciplining of Christians.⁴

It is apparent from a review of Care Net materials that providing low-income housing on a neutral basis is not among its objectives. It is also apparent that evangelical Christianity is inherent in the organization's programming. Secular programming and objectives cannot be separated out.

Non-Discrimination Violations

We understand that Care Net has submitted a letter dated January 9, 2013, to try to address concerns about its religious activity and government financing for the housing project. However, the letter does little to resolve concerns.

The letter says, "Care Net has chosen to develop Eagle Harbor Apartments as a means to provide safe, affordable housing to residents graduating from The Elizabeth House, as well as others seeking affordable workforce housing." Care Net's Reserve Fund application describes the "target population" as "women that have previously lived in The Elizabeth House." The Elizabeth House is a "Christian residential program for pregnant women." In effect, Care Net seeks to utilize the new facility for participants in its Christian programming. This is not providing housing on a neutral basis. The new apartments seem to be intended as an extension of its Christian ministry.

The application also says that a community room in Eagle Harbor Apartments "can be used by Care Net to provide services to residents." Presumably, these programs will be conducted in accordance with Care Net's evangelical Christian perspective.

We are unaware of any protections that will be made so that residents have recourse if Care Net seeks to proselytize and advance its views upon residents. Christians of other denominations, non-Christians, and the non-religious will not be comfortable living in an environment where they are preached at or encouraged to participate in Care Net religious activities. While Care Net has named a property manager, it remains to be seen what role Care Net will have in relation to the apartments. It is not enough assurance that Care Net will not *require* a certain religious affiliation, it cannot seek to influence the religious beliefs or non-religious views of residents at the facility. Given the mission and proselytizing programming of Care Net, its assurances of fair housing practices ring hollow.

We also understand that if the project is approved, Care Net will enter into a contract with the City and agree to abide by certain non-discrimination provisions. We understand that these provisions typically include the following language as required by City of Madison ordinances:

Non-Discrimination. For the purposes of this Section, Contractor shall mean Borrower. **In the performance of the services under this Agreement the Contractor agrees not to discriminate against any employee or applicant because of race, national origin or ancestry, color, religion, sex, age, handicap/disability, marital status, source of income, arrest record, or conviction record, less than honorable discharge, physical appearance, sexual orientation, political beliefs, familial status, or the fact that such person is a student or the fact that such person is a member of a domestic partnership as defined in MGO 39.03.** Contractor further agrees not to discriminate against any subcontractor or person who offers to subcontract on this contract because of race, religion, color, age, disability, sex or national origin. (emphasis added).

Care Net discriminates on the basis of religion in selecting employees and volunteers.⁵ Even with a property manager to handle tenants, Care Net is still the owner and contracting party with the City. Care Net staff will likely be involved in making key arrangements and decisions surrounding the facility and its construction. We fail to see how Care Net could abide by the required non-discrimination provisions.

Conclusion

We urge the Committee to reject the proposal. Care Net does not have experience or a proven track record in developing low-income housing of this type. Appointing a third party to manage the property is not sufficient; Care Net is the owner and contracting party with the City. Care Net has a mission and track record of proselytizing in providing non-housing related services. The "target group" of residents is a select group of participants in a Christian residential program. Overall, there are not adequate safeguards to ensure that the units will truly be welcoming to all comers on a neutral basis.

Dear prospective team member,

We're so glad that you're considering volunteering at Care Net Pregnancy Center. Calling us, visiting our website or stopping by to receive this information packet may have been an easy thing or very hard thing to do. Some women just know this is how they want to volunteer, so it's easy for them. Others believe they want to help, but the secret of a past abortion(s) hinders them from joyfully serving. If you're one who has had an abortion(s) continue on: this letter is for you.

It's not uncommon for women who have had an abortion to want to prevent others from making that same decision. Some may feel that if they can assist others to carry to term, it may alleviate their own sadness and hurt.

Then there's the woman, like myself, who deep down longed to help but also longed for healing and closure to my own dark secret of abortion. I hoped that by volunteering at a "Pregnancy Care Center" I could have both. My hopes were answered. I was able to expose this secret, be accepted and was encouraged to help others.

Many times I doubted my ability to help, wondering how useful my story would be. I thought telling it would only condone abortion, i.e., this counselor did this so it must be all right. But the Lord has used my story and vulnerability with clients to minister truth. He will use yours also.

The Lord led me to the right place, and I believe He also led you. God has begun a healing already in this area of your life, or you wouldn't be applying here. We praise God He has brought you this far. In *Isaiah 43:19* we have more to praise Him for. It tells us, "See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up. Do you not perceive it?" He desires to close that wound so that you can minister to others with compassion, boldness and assurance of His forgiveness.

How does this happen? Through a post-abortion Bible study called "*Forgiven and Set Free.*" We, along with our parent organization Care Net National strongly encourage you to participate in this study prior to your first solo counseling session. You are important to us, and we want to do all we can to insure the best volunteer experience for you and your clients. Those who have completed the study have said this study reduced their doubts, and that they can now share their experience with hope that it will make a difference in another woman's life. Care Net is a mission field, and women come to us looking for wisdom to help them make the "right" decision. We desire to equip you with all the resources available so you can counsel to the best of your ability, depending completely on the Holy Spirit's guidance and discernment. He will give you the right words for every precious woman you counsel.

The Bible study is free of charge and available individually or in a group. All contact is completely confidential. I look forward to meeting you, and I praise God for your courage to step out and volunteer.

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Statement of Principles

1. Care Net Pregnancy Center of Dane County ("Care Net") is an outreach of Jesus Christ through His Church. Commensurate with this purpose, those who labor as Care Net board members, directors, staff and volunteers must know Christ as their Savior and Lord.
2. Care Net is committed to providing its clients with accurate and complete information about both prenatal development and abortion.
3. Care Net is committed to adopting and enforcing internal procedures to assure that abortion education is performed in a caring and compassionate manner with due respect for the emotional sensibilities of each client. Prior to usage by the center, client materials containing descriptions or depictions of abortion will be reviewed by a qualified medical professional (ex: physician, nurse) and determined to be medically accurate. Materials with graphic depictions of abortion or its results are not content appropriate when the primary effect of such materials is to shock rather than to educate. When using approved abortion education materials with clients, center personnel will always give specific warnings and obtain written client permission before showing any videos, brochures, or diagrams that contain any visual depictions of abortion or its results. No client will ever be asked, pressured or coerced to view abortion education materials which she or he has indicated a desire not to see.
4. Care Net is committed to assisting women to carry to term by providing emotional support and practical assistance. Through the provision of God's people and the community at large, women may face the future with hope and plan constructively for themselves and their babies.
5. Care Net does not discriminate on any basis* in providing services.
6. Care Net never advises, provides, or refers for abortion or abortifacients.
7. Care Net offers assistance free of charge at all times.
8. Care Net is committed to creating an awareness within the local community of the needs of pregnant women and of the fact that abortion does not solve problems; it compounds them.
9. Care Net does not engage in contraceptive counseling or in referring for contraceptives or contraceptive services. (Married women seeking contraceptive information should be urged to seek counsel, along with their husbands, from their pastor and physician.)
10. Care Net recognizes the validity of adoption as one alternative to abortion, but is not biased toward adoption when compared to other life-saving alternatives. The Center is independent of adoption agencies, relating to them in the same manner as to other helpful referral sources. Care Net receives no payments of any kind from these agencies, does not enter into contractual relationships with them, and does not share combined office space. Adoption agencies are not established under the auspices of centers. Care Net neither initiates nor facilitates independent adoptions.
11. Care Net is committed to integrity in dealing with clients, earning their trust, providing promised information and services, and eschewing any form of deception in its corporate advertising or individual conversation.
12. Care Net is against any and all violent forms of opposition to abortion. We believe all our actions must stem from the LOVE of Christ, working through us.
13. Because the Bible teaches we are to love all people, including those who may not love us, the staff and volunteers, including the Board of Directors of Care Net make it a policy never to speak, directly or indirectly, about a specific abortion clinic, abortionist, or any staff person of any clinic while counseling a client and/or representing the Care Net in any way.

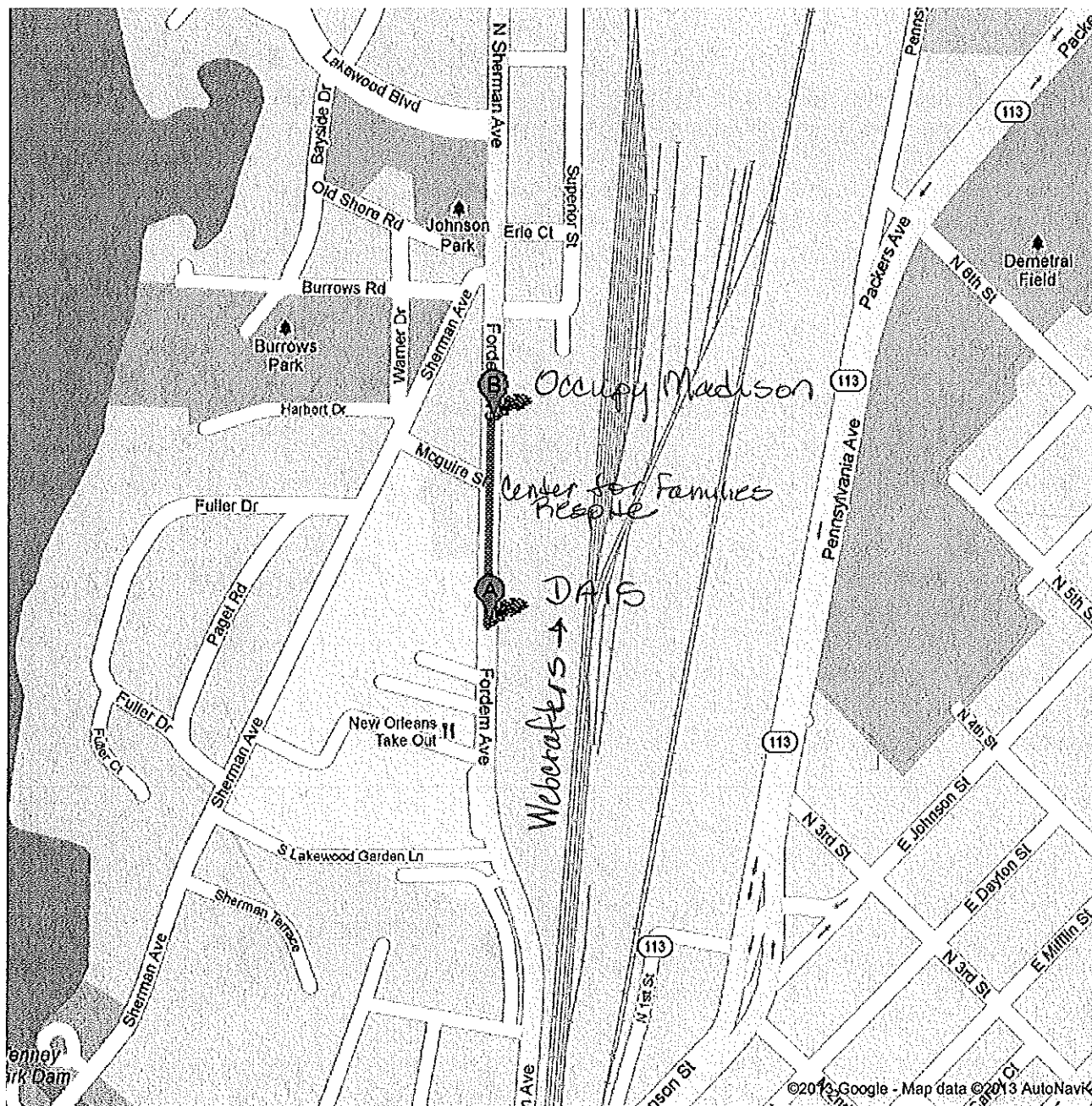
