WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Madison adopted a preliminary resolution, declaring its intention to exercise police powers and special assess costs for installation of traffic signals at Crossroads Drive-High Crossing Blvd intersection and all other statutory requirements, pursuant to sec. 66.0703(4), Wis Stats; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works having reported on all the proceedings in relation to the installation of traffic signals at Crossroads Drive-High Crossing Blvd intersection in accordance with section 66 0701 of the Wisconsin Statutes and having in all things duly conformed to the order of the Common Council in relation thereto, and the provisions of the Madison General Ordinances and the Wisconsin Statutes in such case made and provided, and the Common Council being fully advised;


