But what we are very upset with is the possible decision to add sidewalks, which in our opinion are unwanted and unnecessary. Not only will we lose a fourth of our front lawns to cement, which in our 3 blocks of Turner Ave will be 20,000 square feet of concrete. But also at least 20 mature trees will be removed, many as old as the homeowners themselves, along with the shade and comfort they provide.
