Re: Proposed Street Reconstruction Project & Public Hearing

The City of Madison is proposing to install pervious concrete sidewalk along E. Wilson Street along with a pedestrian crossing of the rail road tracks at the extension of S. Few Street as part of Phase 1B of Central Park. Enclosed with this letter please find a notification for the Public Hearing before the Board of Public Works. The date, time and location of the public hearing can be found on the notification.

This project will involve special assessments to the owners of property adjacent to the project. The property owners will be assessed for new sidewalk in accordance with the City's assessment policty. This portion of the project is federally funded and the assessments are based on the City's proportionate share of the cost, which is 20% of all eligible expenses.

The pervious concrete sidewalk will be 7ft in width. The City will retain maintenance of the sidewalk for clearing and snow removal. The City will assess the sidewalk based on the price of a typical 5ft wide standard concrete sidewalk.

The installation of new sidewalk will require connection of the existing building downspouts to the storm sewer system to minimize drainage and icing of the sidewalk during cold weather. The storm sewer work required as part of this project is not assessable.

The pedestrian crossing of the railroad tracks at the extension of S. Few Street is not assessable. This work will include the installation of new storm sewer, sidewalk and bike path ramps, new pavement for the crossing and for the plaza area within the park.

Enclosed is a Schedule of Assessments, which shows the estimated costs for each property adjacent to the project. After the work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on bid prices and work actually performed. The final assessment, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of eight years, with 3.5% interest charged on the unpaid balance.
