DRAFTER’S ANALYSIS: Section 7.07(8)(g) is amended to decrease annual permit fees for food and drink permits. Section 7.08(7)(b) is amended to decrease the annual fee for a temporary restaurant. Section 7.15(6)(e) is amended to decrease the annual fee for a tattoo or body-piercing establishment. Section 7.51(3) is amended to decrease fees for hotels, motels and tourist rooming houses. Section 7.52(4) is amended to decrease fees for recreational and educational camps. Section 7.53 is amended to decrease campground license fees. This ordinance reduces annual fees for Food and Drink Permit, Tattoo and Body Piercing Fees, Hotels, Motels, Bed and Breakfast Establishments and Tourist Rooming Houses, Recreational and Educational Camps and Campgrounds. These businesses have been heavily affected by COVID-19 and the reduction lowers the fees to pre-pandemic amounts.

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

1. The table of Subdivision (g) of Subsection (8) entitled “Food and Drink Permit” of Section 7.07 entitled “Regulations Regarding Foods Handled by Public Places” of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

\$0 - \$10,000	\$223 <u>190</u>
\$10,001 - \$100,000	\$493 <u>421</u>

\$500,001 - \$1,000,000	\$910 <u>777</u>
\$1,000,001 - \$5,000,000	\$1094 <u>935</u>
Greater than \$5,000,000	\$1215 <u>1038</u> ”

2. Subdivision (b) entitled “Fee” of Subsection (7) entitled “Temporary Restaurant” of Section 7.08 entitled “Regulations Governing Eating and Drinking Establishments” of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

“(b) Fee. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 97.615, the fee for an annual permit to operate a temporary food establishment may be one hundred ~~and ninety~~ twenty five dollars (~~\$190~~ 125).”

3. Paragraph 1. of Subdivision (e) entitled “Fees” of Subsection (6) entitled “Licensing and Fees” of Section 7.15 entitled “Regulation of Tattooing and Body-Piercing” of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

- “1. Annual establishment fees shall be:
 - a. Tattoo or body-piercing establishments, ~~\$335~~ 286.
 - b. Combined tattoo and body-piercing establishments, ~~\$438~~ 374.
 - c. Pre-inspection, one-time only, ~~\$250~~ 225.
 - d. First Reinspection Fee, \$150.
 - e. Subsequent Reinspection Fee, \$250.”

4. The table entitled “Hotels and Tourist Rooming Houses” of Subsection (3) entitled “Fees” of Section 7.51 entitled “Hotels, Motels, Bed and Breakfast Establishments and Tourist Rooming Houses” of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

"Hotels and Tourist Rooming Houses:

1 - 4	\$175 - 149
5 - 30	\$244 - 209
31 - 99	\$348 - 297
100 - 199	\$502 - 429
200 or more	\$567 - 484

Bed and Breakfast Establishments: ~~\$175~~149"

5. The table of Subsection (4) entitled "Fees" of Section 7.52 entitled "Recreational and Educational Camps" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

"Number of Camps at Same Location	Fee
1 - 5	\$351 - 300
6 - 10	\$468 - 400
11 or more	\$819 - 700 "

6. The table of Subsection (4) entitled "Fees" of Section 7.53 entitled "Campgrounds" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

"Number of Sites at Same Location	Fee
1 - 25	\$234 - 200
26 - 100	\$410 - 350
Over 100	\$585 - 500 "
