Housing Initiatives seeks funds to match Federal Supportive Housing funds and acquire six permanent housing units for chronically homeless persons

B. Movin' Out: Hilton Drive and Eldorado Lane (2006/05-C)

Movin' Out, in concert with the Wisconsin Initiative for Sustainable Housing, requests Housing Development Funds to help acquire two properties that would serve households with disabilities. (Note two applications, combined into one staff review.)

C. Arboretum Co-Housing and Habitat (2006/05-D)

ARCO and Habitat seek a commitment of funds for eligible homebuyers in their emerging co-housing development planned in conjunction with St. Mary's Hospital. (Note two proposals for the Acquisition/Rehab Fund were submitted but the current low level of funds are insufficient to fund either one.)

MDC requests a satisfaction of two mortgages and then re-recording of a single mortgage at the increased valuation of the previous mortgage in order to redevelop two properties on W. Mifflin Street.
