We see there is another public hearing scheduled March 22 regarding the water tower on West Old Sauk Road. We own the farm adjacent to the water tower and ask that the City of Madison please proceed with building the water tower without any further delay. We also do not understand any reason for holding any further public hearings since we went thru all those procedures to the point of exhaustion in the 1990's with the residents of the Town of Middleton voting and approving that our farm along with every other property east of Pioneer Road fall into the city of Madison jurisdiction. The site for the water tower was purchased many years ago by the City of Madison with the efforts of John McKenzie, Arthur Pope and our family. The residents of the Town of Middleton no longer have any jurisdiction east of Pioneer Road. We along with our neighboring property owners east of Pioneer Road are ready to develop approximately 400 acres of our farm land adding substantial property tax base to the City of Madison. We have patiently waited nearly 18 years for the water tower to be built and ask that it be built as soon as possible so we can move on with our development projects.
