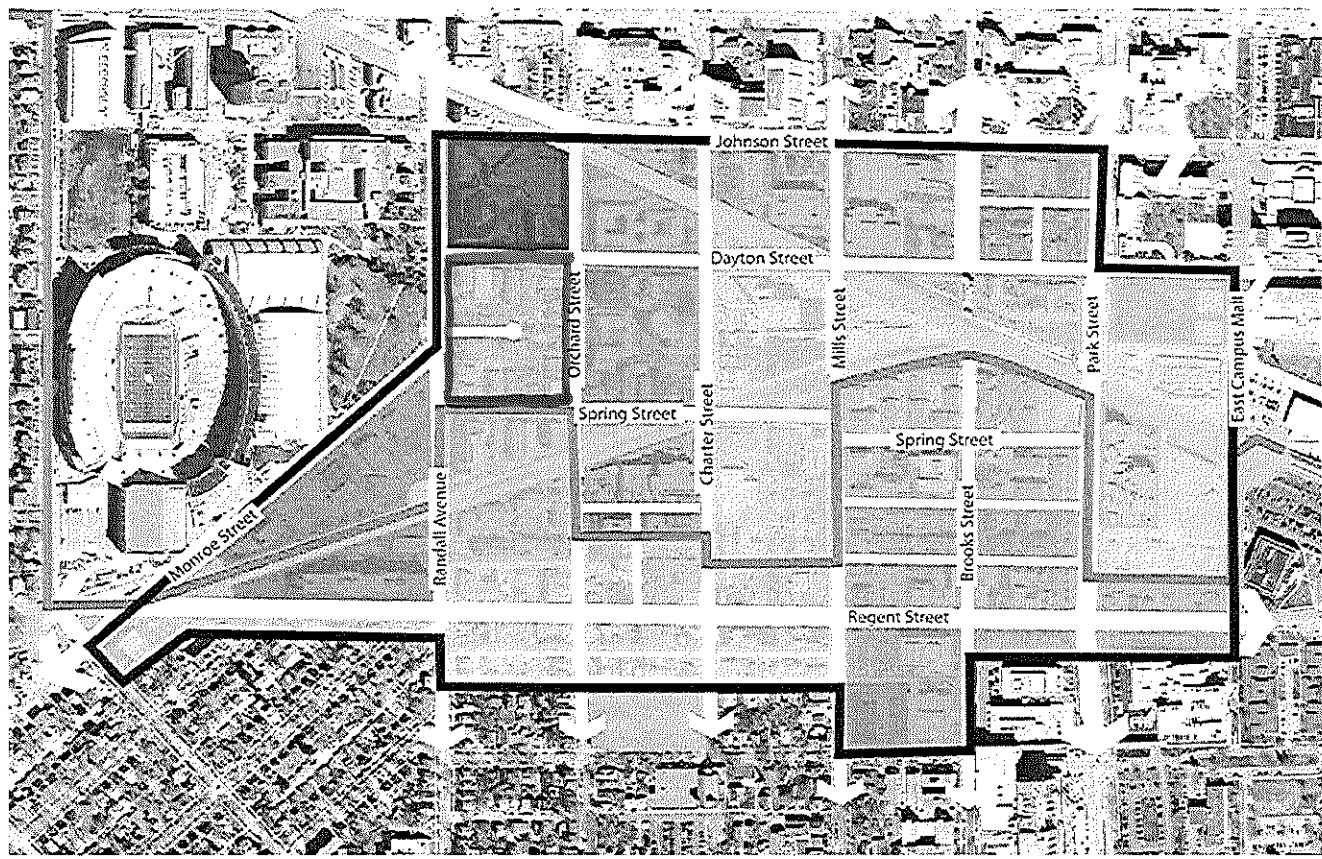


Map 3.7:
