

- 405 Commissioned personnel
- Daily staffing of 88 personnel
 - 14 Stations
 - 12 Engines
 - 5 Ladders
 - 9 Ambulances
 - 1 Command Vehicle
 - Lake Rescue Team
 - Haz Mat Team
 - Heavy Urban Rescue Team
 - Fire Investigation Team
- 39 Civilian personnel
 - 18 in Fire Prevention
 - 7.75 in Community Paramedicine, including CARES
 - 14 administrative staff

- ► 41,328 total incidents
- ► 28,253 EMS responses
- **▶** 21,358 ambulance transports

COMMUNITY ALTERNATIVE RESPONSE EMERGENCY SERVICES (CARES)

- ► Started in Sep 2021 with 1 team
- Expanded to 2 teams in April 2022
- Expanded to 3 teams in April 2024



CARES RESPONSES

- ► Target responses are non-violent, behavioral health emergencies
- ► Teams are activated through triage with 911 dispatchers or requests from MFD/MPD

- \circ 2022 total calls = 1,480
- \circ 2023 total calls = 2,548
- 2024 calls through September = 2,590

COMMUNITY ALTERNATIVE RESPONSE EMERGENCY SERVICES (CARES)

▶ Pilot expansion to Sun Prairie projected at the end of 2024

October 2024 relocation to remodeled office space at 1234 E. Washington Avenue.
