- E. Disabled parking in Park lot (Access granted to individuals at Buick and Taft only with proper vehicle tags and/or plates.

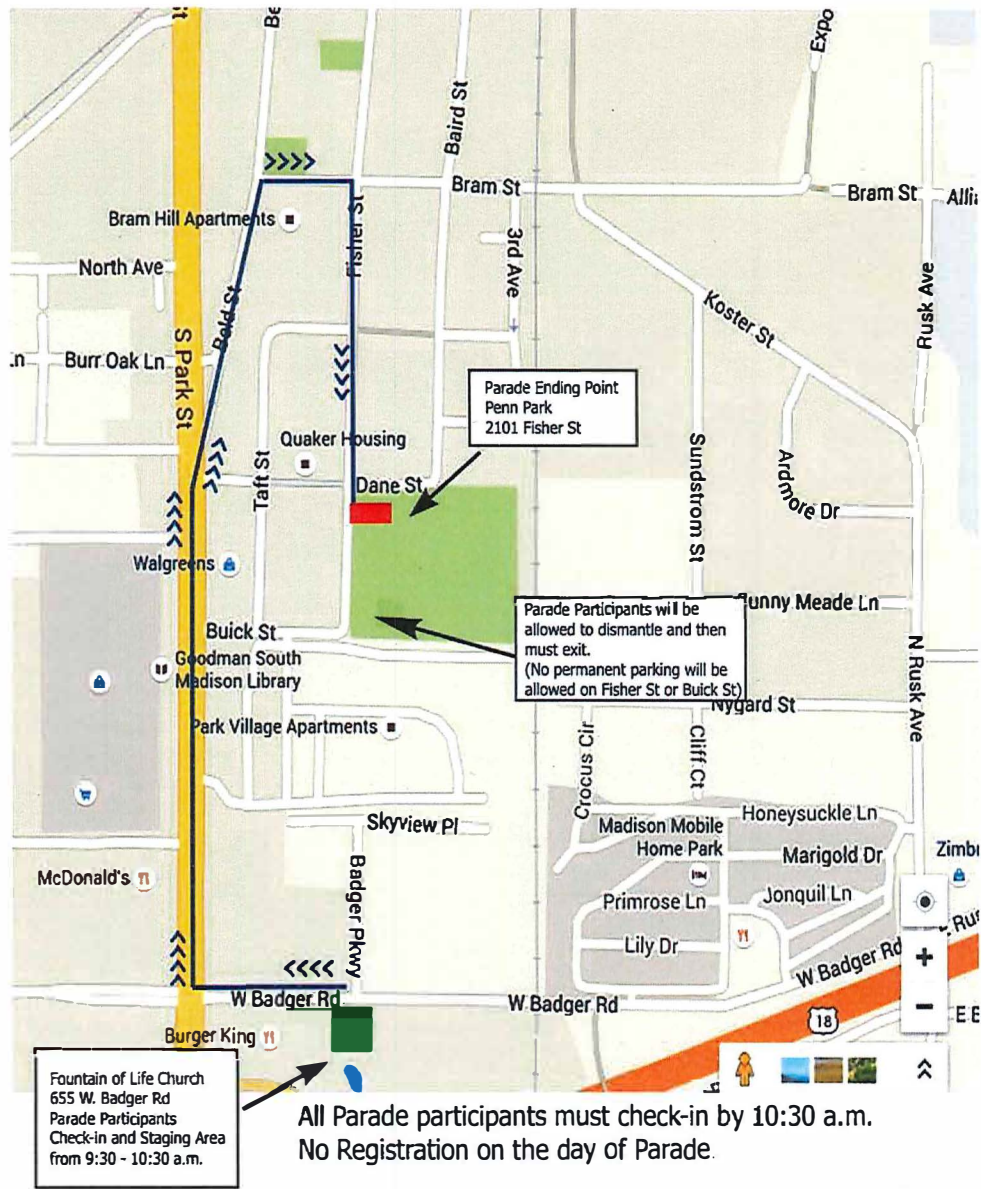
