To: Property Owners along Julia Street, Julia Circle and Baker Avenue

Re: Proposed Street Project & Public Hearing

The City of Madison is proposing to reconstruct Baker Avenue, and resurface Julia Street and Julia Circle in 2020. Enclosed with this letter is a fact sheet with some details on the proposed project, which includes a map of the proposed project limits. Also enclosed is a notification for the Public Hearing before the Board of Public Works. The date, time and location of the public hearing can be found on the notification.

This project will involve special assessments to the owners of property adjacent to the project. The property owners will be assessed for various items included with this proposed project, and the costs of some of those items are assessed entirely to the owner. A table detailing the City's standard assessment policy for the items of work is included on the fact sheet.

Also enclosed is a Schedule of Assessments, which shows the estimated costs for each property adjacent to the project. After the work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on bid prices and work actually performed. The final assessment, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 3% interest charged on the unpaid balance.

To request accommodations for special needs or disabilities or if you have any other questions regarding this project, please contact the Project Engineer. This includes requests relating to the Public Hearing and also requests relating to the actual operations of construction. A list of contacts for this project can be found on the enclosed fact sheet.

That on <u>WEDNESDAY</u>, <u>APRIL 22, 2020 AT 4:45 P.M.</u>, the Board of Public Works will be held remotely and the public can attend using a laptop or call in by phone. The Board will consider any objections that may be filed in writing or in person and hear all persons desiring to be heard, and;

That special assessments may be paid over an eight (8) year period, with the owner paying 1/8 of the principal each year plus three (3%) percent interest on the unpaid balance, as determined by the Board of Public Works.

That if the total assessment is paid in full before October 31st in the year that the billing is made, irrespective of project completion, then no interest shall be charged.

Fact and Details Sheet: PROPOSED JULIA ST, JULIA CIR & BAKER STREET PROJECT

Project Details - Proposed Work

Street: The City will remove and replace the asphalt pavement on Julia St and Julia Circle. Curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveways will be replaced on an as needed basis. Baker Ave will have new asphalt and base installed, new curb and gutter will be added to both sides of the street.

Sanitary Sewer: The City will replace existing mains (1967), and in most cases replace laterals from the main to the property line. In limited cases: where the existing lateral is cast iron, appears to be in good condition upon inspection, and runs under a tree the lateral will only be replaced to the back of curb. In those cases, the resident will not be assessed for the additional footage of replacement that is not completed. If you would like a full lateral replacement to the property line in cases such as this please, contact the Sanitary Sewer Contact listed at right.

Storm Sewer: New storm sewer installation and upgrades. Connections of private storm sewer will be completed per City standards (assessable). The City will extend storm sewer and place inlets with storm laterals along the project to allow property owners to connect private drainage or sump pumps. Connection points will be placed behind the sidewalk or at the property lines and then plugged. If you wish to not have a private connection, please contact the project manager.

Water Main: No work proposed

Bus Pad: There is not a bus route along these streets. No bus pads are proposed at this time.

Terrace Areas: All existing concrete terrace walkways will be replaced with the project (assessable), unless the property owner requests that they be removed. The terrace area and public right-of-way will likely be disturbed during the project. Owners must remove any plantings, structures or special landscaping features from the terrace area and public right-of-way, prior to the start of construction, including raised planting beds, stone landscaping, retaining walls, railings, pavers, planters, etc. If left in place, these items will be removed by the contractor. The contractor will not replace these items following completion of the project.

Trees: There are not any trees scheduled for removal at this time. City Forestry will prune the trees within the project limits that will remain prior to the start of construction. If, during the course of construction, it is determined that any additional trees must be removed, adjacent property owners will be notified, prior to removal of the tree. The trees within the project limits that remain may have the roots trimmed during construction. Terrace areas will be evaluated by Forestry for new trees or replacements following the project.

Assessments: After construction is complete, the assessments are recalculated based on the bid prices and measured quantities. The final assessments are mailed in the summer of 2021. Property owners can pay the assessments in a lump sum or over 8 years with 3% interest.

Construction Schedule & Impacts

Tentative Schedule: 60-75-day construction contract length (Start in July of 2020).

Traffic Impacts: The streets will be closed to through traffic within the project limits. Access will be maintained to driveways unless work is directly in front of driveway and if or when the curb and gutter and driveway is being poured. Residential driveways may be closed for up to 2 weeks to allow the concrete time to cure. Local access to residences and businesses will be maintained, but access on dead end streets may be especially difficult during the work day, while the utility installation is being done.

The contractor work hours are 7am to 7pm and no parking is allowed on the street during that time.

Water Shut-offs: None anticipated with the project.

Refuse Collection: It will be the contractor's responsibility to allow for refuse collection to continue during construction. Please mark your address on your cart to make sure it is returned if moved. Have your cart out by 5am on day of pick-up or put out the night before.

Supplemental Forestry Information

Tree pruning in advance of the project is required to reduce the risk of damage to the trees during construction. The City of Madison Forestry Section will perform the necessary work. For certain species, especially oak and elm trees, the pruning must be completed by April 1st to reduce the chance of disease. If additional trees need to be removed, City Engineering will notify the adjacent property owner prior to removal.

Street trees provide many benefits to our city and are considered an important part of the city's infrastructure. Forestry Section staff will evaluate the terrace for new planting sites and potential replacement sites when the project is complete. There is no additional cost to the adjacent property owner for a tree planting. Street trees are typically planted in the spring of the year following the completion of the construction project. Per Madison General Ordinance 10.10, City Forestry determines tree species and planting locations. Residents cannot choose or plant their own tree in the terrace.
