The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 3.46 entitled "Obsolete Committees and Commissions" of the Madison General Ordinances is created to read as follows:

"3.46 OBSOLETE COMMITTEES AND COMMISSIONS.

If any board, committee or commission of the City has not met during a calendar year, the board, committee or commission may be abolished by an order of the Mayor issued after April 1 of the year succeeding the year in which the board, committee or commission did not meet. The Mayor may not abolish any such board, committee or commission if the Common Council acts prior to April 1 to retain the board, committee or commission, or if the board, committee or commission is required by statute or contract. On or before March 1 each year, the Mayor shall submit a report to the Common Council, to be referred to the Common Council Organizational Committee, designating those boards, committees, or commissions to be eliminated pursuant to this section."
