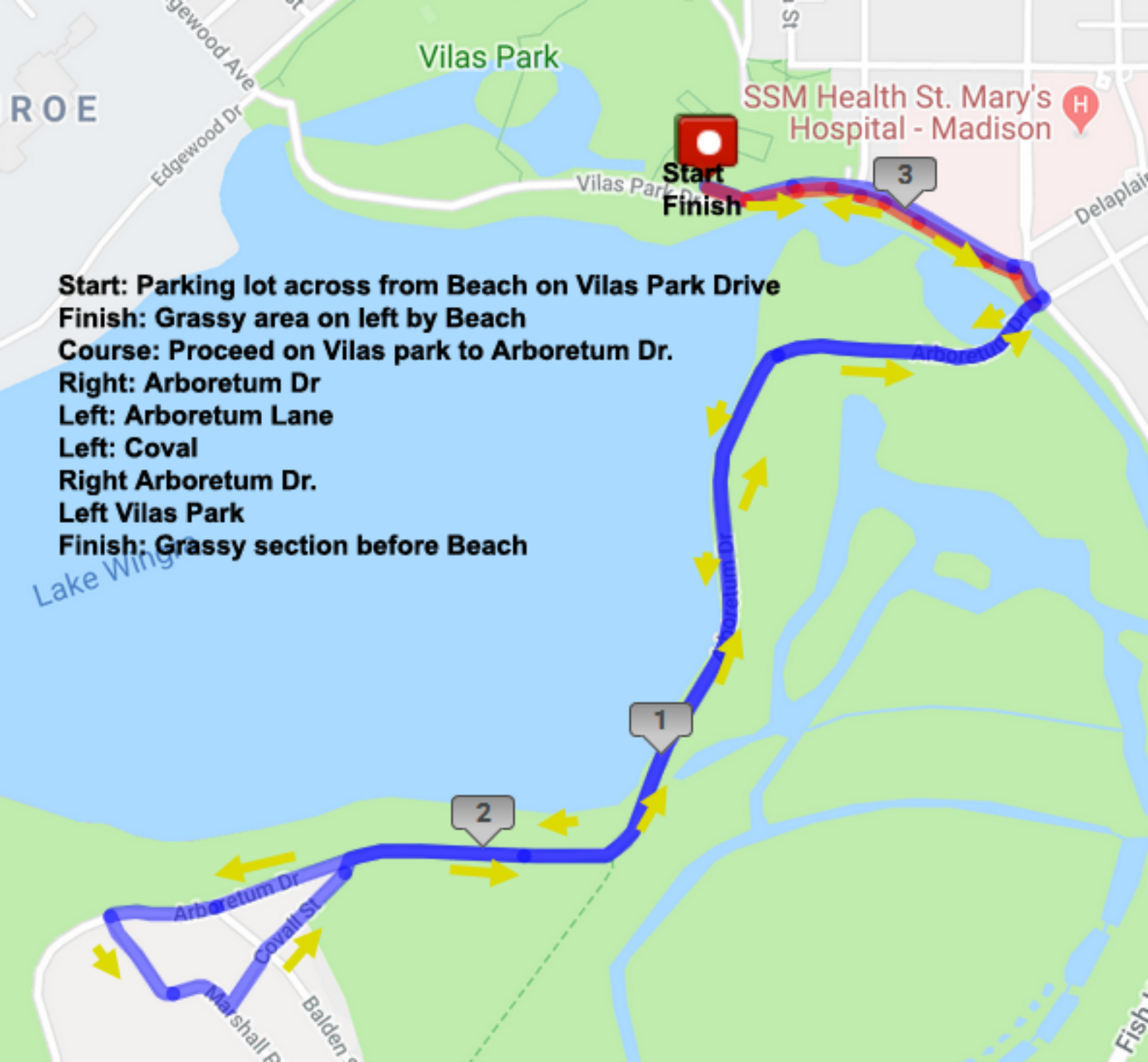

Medical:

An ambulance will be hired to be positioned at the finish area. Along the course, all volunteers will have a direct number to call if runners have any medical issues. At the finish there will be a complete list of all registered runners with emergency contact name and numbers.

Aid Station: One aid station with water will be placed at mile 1.5 on Arboretum.

Security & Safety:

Corner Marshals: All corners will have a safety marshal volunteer with a safety vest and flag. 2 bike marshals will patrol the course on Arboretum.

Vilas Park Drive:

Cones will be placed in the center lane on Vilas Park Drive from start to the Arboretum Drive. Once the runners are past this first half mile the cones will be moved in to a 2-3 runner wide coned lane so autos can then use the road driving carefully

Arboretum Drive will be closed for the duration of the race.

We will have on-site Police:

Police will be positioned according to a plan approved by Police.

- Lead Police Car – then finish area
- Corner of Arboretum / N. Wingra

- Corner of Vilas /S. Millis Street

Police: University of WI

University Police may be used on Arboretum by Coval and Marshal

Severe Weather: The race will be held rain or shine, but will be cancelled if any major weather event occurs or deemed unsafe by the Police. We will follow the 30/30 rule
