Dear Mr. Staffeldt:

The three-lot certified survey of your property located at 708 Heartland Trail, Section 15, Township 7N, Range 8E, City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, is hereby **conditionally approved**. The site is zoned RPSM (Research Park – Specialized Manufacturing District). The conditions of approval from the reviewing agencies to be satisfied before final approval and recording of the CSM are:

Please contact Janet Dailey, City Engineering, at 261-9688 if you have questions regarding the following seven conditions:

1. For record evidence determination between public and private ownership of proposed facilities, provide Engineering-Mapping recorded copies of all three of the intended documents submitted with this Certified Survey Map (CSM) application which are intended to be recorded consecutively after the CSM recording:
 - Amended and Restated Declaration of Joint Driveway Easement
 - Amended and Restated Declaration of Stormwater Drainage Easement
 - Declaration of Easements
2. Prior to approval provide an agreement for the shared private sanitary sewer main. Said agreement shall establish the rights and responsibilities for ownership and maintenance [to be approved by the City Engineering Division].
3. If the lots within this certified survey map are inter-dependent upon one another for storm water runoff conveyance, and/or a private drainage system exists for the entire site an agreement shall be provided for the rights and responsibilities of all lot owners. Said agreement shall be reviewed and placed on file by the City Engineer, referenced on the certified survey map and recorded at the Dane County Register of Deeds.
4. A minimum of two working days prior to requesting City Engineering signoff on the CSM, the applicant shall contact Janet Dailey (261-9688) to obtain the final stormwater utility charges that are due and payable prior to sub-division of the properties. The stormwater utility charges (as all utility charges) are due for the previous months of service. All charges shall be cleared prior to the land division (and subsequent obsolesces of the existing parcel).
5. All outstanding Madison Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) and City of Madison sanitary sewer connection charges are due and payable prior to Engineering sign-off, unless otherwise collected with a

Developer's/ Subdivision Contract. Contact Janet Dailey (261-9688) to obtain the final MMSD billing a minimum of two working days prior to requesting City Engineering signoff.

6. Wisconsin Administrative Code A-E 7.08 identifies when Public Land System (PLS) tie sheets must be filed with the Dane County Surveyor's office. The Developer's Surveyor and/or Applicant must submit copies of required tie sheets or condition reports for all monuments, including center of sections of record, used in this survey, to Eric Pederson, City Engineering. If a new tie sheet is not required under A-E 7.08, Engineering requests a copy of the latest tie sheet on record with Dane County Surveyor's Office. The Applicant shall identify monument types on all PLS corners included on the CSM. Note: Land tie to two PLS corners required.
7. Prior to Engineering final sign-off by main office for Certified Survey Maps (CSM), the final CSM must be submitted to the Engineering Division Surveyor/ Land Records Coordinator for final technical review and approval. This submittal must occur a minimum of two working days prior to final Engineering Division sign-off. Electronic mail submittal of the **final** CSM in PDF format is preferred and should be transmitted to epederson@cityofmadison.com.

Please contact Dennis Cawley, Madison Water Utility, at 266-4651 if you have any questions regarding the following item:

8. Each lot shall have a separate water service lateral connected to a public water main. The Water Utility will not need to sign off the final plans, but will need a copy of the approved plans.

Please contact my office at 261-9632 if you have questions about the following item:

9. A planned commercial site created after October 6, 1998 shall have a plan and reciprocal land use agreement approved by the Traffic Engineer, City Engineer and Director of Planning and Community and Economic Development recorded in the office of the Dane County Register of Deeds. The applicant shall submit the reciprocal land use agreement and easement documents proposed to govern this three-lot land division for review to the above listed agencies and have the documents approved prior to final signoff of this CSM for recording. The approved and executed reciprocal land use agreement and easements shall be recorded concurrent with the proposed CSM.

Please note that the City Office of Real Estate Services is reviewing the report of title provided with this survey and may have comments. That office will send any comments to you by fax or e-mail. If you have any questions, please contact Jeff Ekola at 267-8719 for more information.

A resolution authorizing the City to sign the CSM and any other documents related to the proposed land division will be approved by the Common Council on November 18, 2008.

As soon as the comments and conditions have been satisfied as verified with a completed affidavit form (enclosed), the original along with the revised Certified Survey Map, with all signatures and approvals from the reviewing agencies, shall be brought to this office for final signoff. You or your client may then record the certified survey at the Dane County Register of Deeds. For information on recording procedures and fees, contact the Register of Deeds at 266-4141.

Upon acceptance and recording of the certified survey map by the Dane County Register of Deeds, please transfer the recorded volume, document number, and page numbers to the copies and forward a copy to this office for our records. The original survey map with the recording information is permanently kept on file in the Dane County Register of Deeds Office. A copy of the recorded document can be obtained from the Register of Deeds Office,

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Room 110, City-County Building or the Real Estate Office in the Madison Department of Planning and Development.

Any appeal from this action, including the conditions of approval, must be filed with the Circuit Court within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter. The approval of this CSM shall be null and void if not recorded in **two years** from the date of the approving resolution.
