RE: Update on TFOGS

Much of the energy and time of the Task Force and staff have focused on two parts of our community outreach efforts: the survey, and the open house.

On August 28, 2019, TFOGS held the first of its Open Houses, at the Atrium in the Village Mall. The TFOGS meets on Wednesday, September 4, to review and debrief the Open House, but about 50 persons signed in as attending. A number of persons filled out the TFOGS Survey. Comments were collected through post it notes and will be evaluated. Little or no use was made of the transportation provided. Food was a big hit.

The second open house is planned for September 24 at the Warner Park Community Center.

The Community Liaisons have turned in over 1000 surveys, and we anticipate having a total of nearly 1700 surveys to evaluate.

The Subcommittees are nearly done with their work. One or more of them may issue supplements to the reports provided earlier.
