#### REPORT TO THE MONONA TERRACE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

## **April 21, 2016**

#### A. Operations

- The rooftop restrooms are near completion. The final walk-through is Friday, April 15. The restrooms should be open to the public next week.
- The exterior landscape contract that was out to bid has been awarded to David J. Frank Landscape Contracting. David J. Frank has been landscaping for Monona Terrace a number of years and it will be good to continue the relationship.
- The elevator/escalator maintenance contract is out for bid through the next couple of weeks.
- Maintenance will start spring cleanup soon, removing accumulated sand from the winter and pressure washing the rooftop.
- Guidelines for drone use on property have been developed and shared with managers.
- The Department of Homeland Security Threat and Vulnerability Assessment Report has been completed and is being analyzed to determine the next steps.
