1. CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL

The Commission held a discussion about the exclusionary nature of this ordinance and its probable negative impacts, such as an increase in homelessness. After reviewing the research and evidence presented, the Commission concluded this law would not make children safer. The Commission discussed other options which may provide a greater, more positive impact on the community. The motion passed by voice vote/other.
