The property owner of 511 W Main St is seeking to appeal the requirements of MGO 27.04(2)(c), MGO 10.18, and MGO 28.142(9)(a) outlined in official notice CB2020-238-03389 directing the property owner to provide garbage and refuse storage facilities adequate for the number of residents in the building. The Board discussed the appeal and asked questions of the applicant and registrant.
