07380 Double-Fill Authorization of Program Assistant III - Neighborhood Preservation
 & Inspection Division.

A motion was made by Verveer, seconded by Rhodes Conway, to RECOMMEND TO COUNCIL TO ADOPT - REPORT OF OFFICER. The motion passed by acclamation.

2. Authorizing the Madison Department of Public Health to accept a grant from the State Department of Health and Family Services-Division of Public Health for \$60.434.

A motion was made by Verveer, seconded by Rhodes Conway, to RECOMMEND TO COUNCIL TO ADOPT - REPORT OF OFFICER. The motion passed by acclamation.

3. Authorizing the Mayor, City Clerk and Chief of Police to accept the FY 2007 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant award in the amount of \$196,252 and to utilize these funds to support several law enforcement initiatives.

4. <u>07519</u> Authorizing Mayor Dave Cieslewicz and Chief Noble Wray to accept a highway safety grant up to \$21,000 from Safe Communities for 'Tween Safety Restraint Initiative activities, i.e., informational contacts and overtime enforcement scheduled for October through December 2007.

5. <u>07220</u>

SUBSTITUTE Amending the 2007 Operating Budget to appropriate \$100,000 from Contingent Reserve for Citywide Neighborhood Safety Initiatives.

Modify the second Resolved clause to add "alders," between "with" and "neighborhood stakeholders" and add at the end "and shall share such plans with the Common Council no later than Oct. 30. 2007."
