At the November 19 LORC meeting, the committee asked staff to provide a summary of possible paths forward to complete the work of this committee. These are organized in no particular order.

- 1. Proceed with the unified historic district ordinance as drafted.
- 2. Proceed with the unified historic district ordinance after reviewing that the New Construction standards did not damage the integrity of the historic districts, but include a request for a LORC 3 to address more detailed New Construction standards in each historic district as part of the official Resolution to complete the process.
- 3. Proceed with the unified historic district ordinance for the Maintenance, Repair, Alterations, and Additions sections, but include the current New Construction standards from each historic district ordinance.
- 4. Proceed with the unified historic district ordinance for the Maintenance, Repair, Alterations, and Additions sections, but include the New Construction standards proposed by Jim Matson for each historic district.
