Ald. Brenda Konkel moved, seconded by Ald. Michael Schumacher to amend the resolution to read:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Efficiency Auditor City staff, in consultation with City staff, the Mayor and alders, shall issue a report outlining the alternatives and details involved in the creation of a centralized constituent services system like a Dial 311 or other hotline for municipal services and information; and,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the report and its findings and recommendations be presented to the Mayor and Common Council and referred to the Board of Estimates <u>and the Common Council Organizational</u> <u>Committee</u>.

Ald. Michael Schumacher offered an amendment that stated a report due back date. Ald. Brenda Konkel deemed the amendment friendly:

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the report and its findings and recommendations be presented to the Mayor and Common Council and referred to the Board of Estimates <u>and the Common Council Organizational</u> <u>Committee</u> <u>by September 1, 2008</u>.
