



FREEDOM SKATE SHOP SUMMER SKATE CAMP
MCPIKE PARK SKATEPARK FEE MODIFICATION
2019-2024

For the past two years (2017 & 2018), Freedom Skate Shop has held successful Summer Skateboarding Camps at McPike Park under a fee modification agreement. Madison Parks and Freedom Skate Shop would like to extend the fee modification to allow for the Summer Skateboarding Camp to occur at McPike Park Skatepark for up to five more years, renewable annually upon mutual agreement. Freedom Skate Shop is a locally owned and operated Madison business who employs people who are extremely passionate about skateboarding and are actively skateboarding. They aspire to introduce skateboarding to more members of the Madison community and support those already skateboarding with accessible and high quality instruction. Madison Parks welcomes opportunities to being more people to use our park amenities and will partner with Freedom Skate Shop through the following agreement conditions:

1. Term. Agreement shall be for a term of one (1) year, beginning upon signing of the document and terminating on March 1, 2020. Agreement may be renewed for an additional one-year term annually for up to four years, upon mutual agreement. Freedom Skate Shop will request renewal in writing by April 30 annually. The fee modification expires on March 1, 2024.
2. Location. McPike Park Skatepark.
3. Use. Freedom Skate Shop will have non-exclusive use of the location, providing adequate space for the public to share the skatepark during camp. This agreement authorizes up to four one-week long sessions on Mondays to Fridays from 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM. The anticipated 2019 dates are as follows: June 17- 21, July 8-12, and August 5-9.
4. Participants. Each camp may have a maximum of 10 participants.
5. Fee. Freedom Skate Shop will pay Madison Parks \$250 per each week of camp. Payment is due at least 14 days before the first day of the camp session.
6. Compliance with Laws. Freedom Skate Shop shall comply with all City, state and federal statutes, ordinances and regulations.
7. Suspension, Cancellation and Termination. Parks shall have the right to terminate and cancel this Agreement if Freedom Skate Shop breaches the terms and conditions of the Agreement. Either party may terminate this Agreement, at its sole election, upon 10 days notice to the other party.
8. Indemnification. Freedom Skate Park shall hold harmless the City of Madison, and its officers, officials, agents, and employees, against all loss or expense. Freedom Skate Shop shall provide a certificate of insurance listing City of Madison as additionally insured.

Summer Skate Camp Outline

DATES :

Camp 1 June 17-21

DAYS & HOURS :

Monday through Friday from 8AM to 11AM

PRICE :

\$250/participant (*tax included)

Incentives included with camp price :

- Special Graphic Freedom Skate Camp T-shirt (*\$20 value)
- Special Graphic Freedom Skate Camp Skateboard Deck - Standard 8" deck (*\$35 value)
- 10% off any in store purchase at Freedom Skate Shop from the Sunday prior to that participant's camp starting through the Saturday following the participant's camp end
- Optional pizza lunch party the final Friday of each camp (further details to come)

Camp Restrictions :

- Helmet is required for all participants under 18 years of age
- Additional pads are encouraged but not required (elbow pads, knee pads, wrist guards)
- A liability waiver is required to be signed for all participants
- Liability waiver is required to be signed by parent/guardian of participant if under 18 years of age

Notes:

- Camp is open to participants of all ages
- Maximum 10 participants per camp
- If all camps fill up there is the possibility of adding an additional camp August 21st – 25th
- In the event of weather interrupting camp or potentially interrupting camp notice will be given 24 hours prior to the start of the following day of camp
- If camp needs to be canceled for two or more days of the camp week a refund of \$25 per day of camp missed will be reissued to each participant
- Please note that if there isn't any active weather but there has been recent weather activity or incoming weather activity that camp may be cancelled for that day. Moisture from recent weather activity in the park produces a hazard to instructors and participants as the terrain may become too slippery to perform on. Also moisture to equipment may cause permanent damage to equipment and hinder the ability of the equipment to operate properly.
- Camp may also be cancelled prior to incoming weather as that there is no form of cover/shelter at the skate park which can create a potentially hazardous situation depending on incoming weather severity
