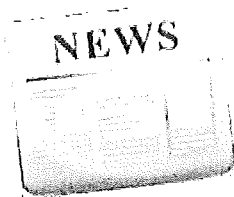

APL in the News

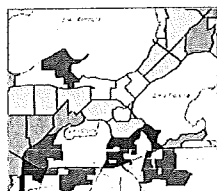

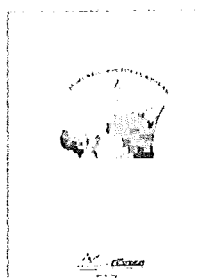

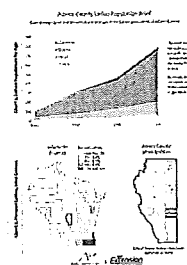
Recent APL Reporting

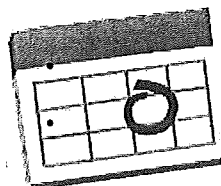
