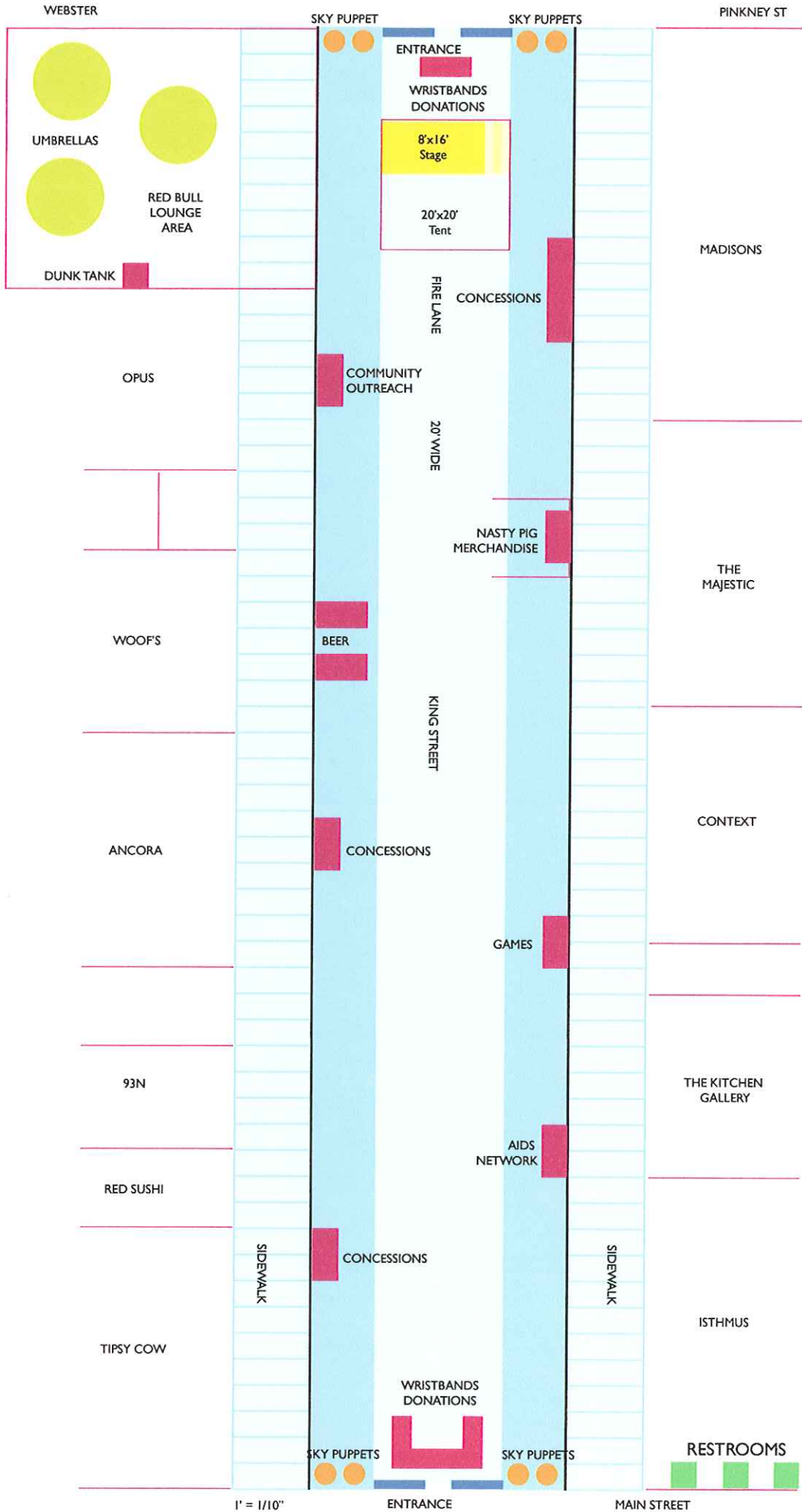

SAFETY/SECURITY PLAN

Using last years exemplary event success as our guide, we will once again enlist a team of 12-16 volunteers as well as our regular 8 staff members to monitor traffic flow, check id's and issue wristbands and help with continual trash pick-up and final street reclamation. We will again use city provided trash receptacles, 9 for trash and 3 for recyclables.

We will coordinate efforts with the Madison Police Department as required as well as with the Madison Fire Department in regards to any/all food preparation that might be considered moving forward. Additionally we have left the 20' required clearance by the Fire Department for street access.

Monitors and clearly identified entrances will be stationed at both ends of King street to check ID's and issue wristbands as well as collect donations, as we felt the single entrance last year on the Main street end of the block was confusing for attendees coming from Pinkney street.

Signage will be affixed at both entrances instructing attendees that no liquor can be taken from the designated street area when exiting.
