


Redistricting


- Process of redrawing wards and aldermanic districts (ADs)

- Equalize population within each AD
- Redistricting will take place at the city, county and state level

City of Madison 2011 Redistricting Existing Aldermanic Districts and Population





City of Madison 2011 Redistricting Existing Wards and Population







Greenfield Multi-Family Development




Infill Multi-Family Development

- Review and update written criteria
- Recommend:
 - Ward Plan (polling places)
 - Aldermanic District Plan

2011 Written Criteria

1. Contain an equal number of inhabitants
 2. Be comprised of contiguous whole wards
 3. Be compact
 4. Enhance participation of diverse residents (race/ethnicity/language) in the political process and their ability to elect representatives of their choice
 5. Contain within them communities of interest (COIs)

6. Use major arterials and other physical barriers as boundaries
 7. Increase the number of districts exposed to future growth
