<b>1. East Isthmus Well Siting</b>																	
Description	Project to replace Well 3 on the east Isthmus to provide adequate water supply to the east central portion of Pressure Zone 6.																
Issues	A working group was formed and using information developed by Montgomery Associates has eliminated any suitable sites in Alder District's 2, 6, and 12. The team is looking at sites in Alder District 15 in the MATC area. Staff is going to reconvene the Working Group to discuss potential well locations.																
<b>2. Zone 4 Water Supply Augmentation Project</b>	11/11/08	11/13/08 12/5/08	11/25/08	1/22/09	12/17/08	3/11/09	3/13/09										
Description	This project was identified in the 2006 Water Master Plan to correct supply redundancy issues and improve fire flow supply capacity within Pressure Zone 4. Pressure Zone 4 is supplied by a single well, No. 9, and the zone has grown to the south and east making the Well 9 hydraulically remote to the southern portion of Pressure Zone 4. This situation has resulted in fire flow supply issues and a need for a redundant supply point within Pressure Zone 4.																
Issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Citizen's Advisory Panel (CAP) has been formed and two meetings have been held. A public meeting was held to introduce the project and the public participation process. A public hearing is scheduled for March 24, 2009 and staff has recommended that a project be established.</li> <li>• The GE property to the east has known contaminants that may be traveling toward a Water Utility owned property on Femrite Drive. The Utility is working closely with GE to evaluate the impact of this information on the Utility's ability to use the property for a potential well site.</li> </ul>																
<b>3. Arbor Hills Supplemental Fire Flow Supply</b>	11/11/08	3/16/09	11/25/08														

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Description	The 2006 Water Master Plan indicated significant widespread fire flow restrictions within the Arbor Hills neighborhood. The area is fed by a single 8-inch pipe along the Beltline Highway frontage road that results in a hydraulic restriction and the area being vulnerable to interruptions in water service due to main breaks. It is noted that there have been three (3) separate main breaks on this pipe during the winter of 2008/2009. The purpose of this project is to improve fire flow capacity and provide a redundant water supply to Arbor Hills.																
Issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Citizen's Advisory Panel (CAP) is being formed for the project and a meeting will be held in early April. A public hearing will be scheduled following the CAP meeting.</li> <li>• The Cannonball Run pipeline, a transmission main that is a critical component for this project and will allow water to be moved from Pressure Zone 6 into Pressure Zone 7, is under design and is planned to be under construction later this year.</li> </ul>																
<b>4. Near West Side Water Supply Augmentation</b>	1/28/09	2/6/09	2/17/09														
Description	Pressure Zone 7 has been identified as having inadequate water supply capacity. This situation was accentuated with the conversion of Well 10 to supply reserve status. Another well in Pressure Zone 7 was recommended in the 2006 Water Master Plan as the means of rectifying the supply redundancy problem.																
Issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Citizen's Advisory Panel (CAP) is being formed for the project and a meeting will be held in early April. A public hearing will be scheduled following the CAP meeting.</li> <li>• The Utility owns property for a well site located at Whitney Way and Mineral Point Road. This site will be evaluated as a part of this project.</li> </ul>																
<b>5. Well 8 Iron and Manganese Mitigation</b>	2/25/09	3/9/09	3/24/09														

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Description	Water Quality concerns at Well 8 due to elevated levels of Iron and Manganese result in customer complaints when the well is in operation. The complaints are due to colored water that stains laundry and plumbing fixtures and an underlying concern about the safety of the discolored water. This condition has limited the Utility's ability to use this well as a significant source of supply to the east central portion of Pressure Zone 6. With the abandonment of Well 3, the ability to utilize Well 8 has become more critical to long term water supply for the east Isthmus.																
Issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Citizen's Advisory Panel (CAP) is being formed for the project and a meeting will be held in early April.</li> <li>• A public meeting will be held following the CAP meeting to present the project to the public.</li> <li>• A public hearing will be scheduled following the public meeting.</li> <li>• Madison Parks is looking into the permitting requirements to modify the existing Well 8 facility and allow the construction of a filter.</li> </ul>																
<b>6. Zone 9 Water Storage</b>																	
Description	The Water Master Plan has identified a storage shortfall in Pressure Zone 9. Adequate storage volumes are needed for emergency supply and fire fighting reserves.
