OBJECTIVE: Identify existing conditions and site amenities/features and analyze how they will impact the planning process.

OUTCOME: Project Base Map; Opportunities and Constraints Analysis

3. STRATEGIC PLANNING WORKSHOPS

OBJECTIVE: Conduct strategic planning workshops with Madison Parks staff to identify Project Vision, Goals, and Strategies.

OUTCOME: Project Vision/Strategies Statement

4. COMMUNITY / STAKEHOLDER OUTREACH AND ENGAGEMENT

OBJECTIVE: Solicit input from stakeholders, partner groups, and community organizations on opportunities and desired amenities.

OUTCOME: Summary of Community Input; Summary of Design Charrette Guidance

5. CONCEPTUAL DESIGNS AND SITE PLANNING RECOMMENDATIONS

OBJECTIVE: Produce conceptual design renderings and site planning recommendations

OUTCOME: Approved Conceptual Design Renderings and Site Plans

6. PRODUCE FINAL PLANNING DOCUMENT

OBJECTIVE: Develop a final planning document for Madison Parks Division that describes the long-term vision for Glenway Woods, serves as a record of the planning process, and contains site plans, concept renderings, and management objectives.
