The Disability Pride Madison planning committee is a group of grassroots activists, with no paid staff. We are individuals with disabilities, allies, family and friends along with representatives of different disability groups that have come together. We are seeking to create community here in Dane County that values and includes people with different kinds of abilities as contributing members. There is a great need to create a culture beyond the limitations that society puts on people because of disability. The phrase, "Disability Pride" is used by people to mean being comfortable with who you are as a person with a disability, valuing yourself for how unique you are and understanding that you are part of a community that has overcome many obstacles and includes many gifted and talented individuals.

On July 27th, 2013 in Brittingham Park, the heart of one of Madison's most diverse and accessible neighborhoods, we will build a community that reflects and affirms us. We plan to have a stage featuring music, theater, poets and speakers celebrating bodies and minds that are outside of the norm. There will also be booths with photographers, painters, graphic artists and craftspeople, as well as non-profits and businesses that want to reach customers from our community. By locating ourselves in Brittingham Park, we are in the shadow of the capitol and very visible in addition to being accessible through public transit.

In 2008, there were close to 40,000 people in Dane County with disabilities. More than one in ten people nationwide and in our county have a disability. Many people with disabilities have traditionally been denied social and cultural opportunities. Disability Pride is promoting them as artists and performers, not just passive audience members. Now, when funding has been drastically cut to many of the support systems that allow people with disabilities to be independent, we want to inspire people with the possibilities.

EXCERPTS FROM APPLICABLE CITY ORDINANCES

8.29 PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEMS IN PARKS.

- (1) No public address systems or sound amplification devices shall be used in any public park within the City of Madison except as permitted by this section. The Parks Superintendent may issue permits in accordance with this section. A permit shall not exempt the holder from the provisions of Sec. 24.08.
- (3) The Superintendent may limit the hours of operation and the location within the park of any such system or equipment so as to insure the benefit of such system or equipment to the group seeking its use and to minimize any unreasonable interference with the peace and enjoyment of other users of the park and those adjacent to such park.
- (5) The Police Department is authorized to require the discontinuance of any such system or equipment operating outside the prescribed hours or location.

24.08 NOISE REGULATION

(2) In the following zoning districts established under Chapter 28 of the Madison General Ordinances, the noise emitted from any source and measured at any point within any distance beyond fifty (50) feet of the property or public right-of-way where the noise is produced or beyond fifty (50) feet from the noise source when such exists on public property shall not exceed the amounts indicated in the following table:
