- Organizers will provide a \$1,000 (refundable) damage deposit with the Parks Division prior to the event and acknowledge that they will be responsible for any and all actual field renovation costs which may result from this event.
- Organizers understand that no permanent marking of streets, paths, or sidewalks 5. will be allowed – chalk may be used, but not spray paint, spray chalk, or stickers.
- Organizers will apply for a Parade Permit from Madison Police (https://www.cityofmadison.com/transportation/forms/paradePermit.cfm?)
- Organizers understand that no driving or parking on the grass is allowed. 7.
- 8. Organizers will be responsible for full clean-up of the park area after the event.
- Amplification will be allowed from 8am to Noon, but sound will be kept to a reasonable level at all times, and particularly early in the morning.
- Organizers will provide a medical/security plan. 10.
- Nothing will be sold in the park; no temporary structures other than 10' X 10' 11. pop-ups will be set up.


